DECISIONS IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

JOHN M. STEVENSON, JR. AND FIRM SUSPENDED

The Commission has instituted and has also disposed of broker-dealer proceedings against John M. Stevenson, Jr. of Houston, Tex. and the registered broker-dealer firm of which he is the sole proprietor, John M. Stevenson, Jr., & Co. At the same time, the Commission suspended the firm's broker-dealer registration for 60 business days, and suspended Stevenson from association with a broker-dealer for the same period.

The sanctions were based on a finding that the United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas enjoined the respondents, with their consent, from violating the securities registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

Respondents consented to the finding and to the sanctions solely to settle the matter and without admitting or denying the basis for the sanctions. (Rel. 34-11651)

GLOBAL SECURITIES, INC. REVOKED; OFFICERS AND SALESMEN BARRED

The Commission has revoked the registration of Global Securities, Inc. of Plainfield, N. J., as a broker-dealer. It has also barred Allen Langenauer, its president, David Langenauer, its vice president, and two of its salesmen, Bernard Oschers and Lee Schneider, from association with any broker, dealer or investment company. The order allows the individual respondents to seek permission from the Commission to become so associated in a non-supervisory and non-proprietary capacity upon a showing of adequate supervision, and to seek relief from the bar order, within specified periods of time.

The sanctions were based on findings that respondents violated the registration provisions of the Securities Act and the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act. The order which initiated the proceedings alleged that these violations had occurred in connection with the common stock of Management Dynamics, Inc.

Respondents consented to the findings and sanctions in offers of settlement for the purpose of settling this proceeding and without admitting or denying the charges against them. (Rel. 34-11652)

ORDERS FOR PUBLIC PROCEEDINGS

ORDER CITES METRO-GOLDWYN-MAYER

Public administrative proceedings have been ordered under Section 15(c)(4) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer (MGM) of Culver City, Calif. These proceedings are based on staff allegations that MGM's Form 10-K for 1974 was deficient. MGM, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to findings of the Commission that the participation by Kirk Kerkorian, MGM's principal shareholder, in the arranging of certain corporate transactions, in part was motivated by a need to meet his obligations to repay his bank loans. The Commission found that the filings made by MGM under Section 13 of the Exchange Act were deficient because they did not disclose certain direct or indirect interests of officers, directors, and principal shareholders in corporate transactions, including the identity of the individual and his relationship to the corporation and the nature and amount of his interest in the transaction. MGM also consented to an order of the Commission requiring that MGM correct its Form 10-K for 1974 and take further corrective action to prevent future deficient filings. (Rel. 34-11649)

COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

RENE R. WOOLCOTT ENJOINED

The New York Regional Office announced that on September 8, upon consent of the defendant, the Honorable Thomas P. Griesa, U. S. District Judge for the Southern District of New York, issued a final judgment of permanent injunction and order of disgorgement enjoining Rene R. Woolcott from further violations of the anti-fraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and directing Woolcott to disgorge the sum of \$6,500, the profit he realized as a result of his unlawful activity. The Commission had alleged that Woolcott had purchased 1,000 shares of Zapata Corporation while in possession of material non-public information concerning a prospective tender offer by Zapata Corporation for its own shares.
