


















Saving Reports

- Saving to My Reports
 - Use to save selected parameters
 - Use to save modified format
- Exporting
 - Excel
 - Adobe PDF

- CDBG Activity for Program Year
 - All open activities
 - Activities with draws in program year
 - Activities with completion date in program year
- CDBG Activity-Level Detail
 - Proposed and Actual
 - Beneficiaries
 - Race/Ethnicity
 - Income
 - Funding and Expenditures
 - Narrative





CDBG Activity Summary Report (PR03)

Good Practice

- Start push for missing data early in process
- Run BOSMAC version first to find what is missing OR print and mark up PDF version
- Run PDF version for final public copy





- Common Issues
 - Unexpended Funds at End of Previous Year
 - Prior Year Flag/Unliquidated Obligations

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PR26 Part 3: Low/Mod Benefit

- Line 17: Expended for Low/Mod Housing in Special Areas
 - CDFI and NRSA activities: all units may be considered to be part of single structure 570.208 (d)(5)-(d)(6)
 - Separate calculation for each area
- Line 18: Expended for Low/Mod Housing
 - 570.200 (a)(3)(iv)
 - Separate calculation for each multi-unit structure

STATE OF TOTAL



PR26 Part 3: Low/Mod Benefit

If CDBG/Total Cost > LM Units/Total Units

credit = Total Cost x %LM Units

If CDBG/Total Cost < LM Units/Total Units

credit = Total CDBG Disbursed

Part 4: Public Service Calculation

- + Current Year Allocation x 15%
- + Prior Year Program Income x 15%
- = TOTAL Available for Services
- + Public Service Disbursements
- Current Year Unliquidated Obligations
 - Prior Year Unliquidated Obligations
- = TOTAL Obligations Subject to Cap

32 ENTITLEMENT GRANT	Sys
33 PRIOR YEAR PROGRAM INCOME	Sys

35 TOTAL SUBJECT TO PS CAP (SUM, LINES 32-34)	Calc
36 PERCENT FUNDS OBLIGATED FOR PS ACTIVITIES (LINE 31/LINE 35)	Calc

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Prior Year Flag vs. Unliquidated Obligations

- Use one or the other, not both
- Prior Year Flag
 - For costs incurred in CAPER year, but not drawn in IDIS until following year
 - Available 90 days after close of program year
 - Credits draw to previous year calculation
- Unliquidated Obligations
 - For budgeted in CAPER year, not incurred until following year.

PR26 Part 5: Admin Cap Formulas

- + Current Year Allocation x 20%
- + Current Year Program Income x 20%
- = TOTAL Available for Admin
- + Admin Disbursements
- + Current Year Unliquidated Obligations
- Prior Year Unliquidated Obligations
- = TOTAL Obligations Subject to Cap

CDBG Financial Summary Report (PR26)

- Summary
 - Always report amount on Line 01
 - Use PR01 to reconcile to Line 16
 - Use the Detail Reports
 - Use BOSMAC PR03 to reconcile
 - You should be fine on caps if you <u>budget</u> correctly





Summary

- Use IDIS reports to:
 - Manage programs on daily basis
 - Ensure compliance with data collection
 - Maintain data integrity
- Report generation gets easier with practice,
 repetition


