COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ORDER ISSUED SUSPENDING TRADING IN SECURITIES OF ASTHMA DISEASE MANAGEMENT, INC.

The Commission announced the temporary suspension, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, of over-the-counter trading of the securities of Asthma Disease Management, Inc. (ADMI), of Berlin, New Jersey at 9 30 a m EDT on May 8, 2000, and terminating at 11.59 p m. EDT on May 19, 2000.

The Commission temporarily suspended trading in the securities of ADMI because of questions that have been raised about the accuracy and adequacy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, purported contracts between ADMI and three health maintenance organizations: Cape Health Plan (f/k/a Cape Medical) of Detroit, Michigan, Horizon Mercy of Trenton, New Jersey, and HMA of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

The Commission cautions broker-dealers, shareholders, and prospective purchasers that they should carefully consider the foregoing information along with all other currently available information and any information subsequently issued by the company

Further, brokers and dealers should be alert to the fact that, pursuant to Rule 15c2-11 under the Exchange Act, at the termination of the trading suspension, no quotation may be entered unless and until they have strictly complied with all of the provisions of the rule. If any broker or dealer has any questions as to whether or not he has complied with the rule, he should not enter any quotation but immediately contact the staff of the Securities and Exchange Commission in Washington, D.C. If any broker or dealer is uncertain as to what is required by Rule 15c2-11, he should refrain from entering any quotations relating to ADMI's securities until such time as he has familiarized himself with the rule and is certain that all of its provisions have been met. If any broker or dealer enters any quotation which is in violation of the rule, the Commission will consider the need for prompt enforcement action

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

REPEAT SECURITIES LAWS VIOLATOR FOUND LIABLE FOR STOCK FRAUD AND ORDERED TO DISGORGE FRAUDULENTLY OBTAINED INVESTOR FUNDS AND PAY MAXIMUM THIRD TIER PENALTY

The Commission announced that on May 1, 2000, the Honorable Florence-Marie Cooper, United States District Judge for the Central District of California, granted the Commission's motion for summary judgment and issued a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Defendants Assured International, Inc., Sam E. Harris, Sharp Financial Corp., Max Becker and Tralana Lee. The Court permanently enjoined Assured, Harris, Sharp, Becker and Lee from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The Court ordered Assured and Sharp to disgorge \$1,270,717.88 and \$136,500, respectively, in fraudulently obtained investor funds, plus prejudgment interest. The Court also ordered

Harris, Becker and Lee to disgorge their ill-gotten gains, together with prejudgment interest, and imposed third tier civil penalties against each of them.

Assured, Harris, Becker and Lee raised \$1,134,217.88 from the sale of Assured stock to investors nationwide through a boiler room operated in Woodland Hills, California. Assured, Harris, Becker and Lee failed to disclose that Harris, a repeat securities laws violator, controlled all investor funds. Assured, Harris, Becker and Lee also misrepresented how investor money would be used. Additionally, Lee and Sharp continued the fraudulent scheme to raise \$136,500 in violation of the temporary restraining order and preliminary injunction issued by the Court [SEC v. Assured International, Inc., Sam E. Harris, Sharp Financial Corp., Max Becker and Tralana Lee, Civil Action No. 99-00530 FMC, BQRx, C D Cal.] (LR-16540)
