## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

### COMMISSION GRANTS ISE EXEMPTION TO ACCOMMODATE ITS ELECTRONIC MARKET IN THE MARKETWIDE DATA SYSTEM

The Commission yesterday granted the International Securities Exchange's (ISE) request for a temporary exemption to accommodate the ISE in the consolidated system for options market information. Absent this exemption, the ISE could have been precluded by the marketwide plan for consolidating information from disseminating its own market data within the ISE's electronic market.

The ISE is the first fully electronic options exchange and will begin trading today in three options classes, with plans to expand to 600 options classes in the future. As an electronic options exchange, the ISE has no "floor." The Commission's action allows the ISE to provide its market data, including quote size, to its members as part of its trading system, like a traditional market provides its information on its floor. The temporary exemption does not permit the ISE or its members to disseminate ISE market data to customers.

In granting this exemption, the Commission reaffirmed its strong support for the dissemination and display of consolidated market data to all market participants. Sole reliance on consolidated options data by ISE members, however, is not currently feasible because this data will not include the size of quotes until January 2001. This temporary exemption is designed to allow the ISE -- beginning today -- to disseminate to its members its own market data under conditions designed to preserve the value of consolidated market information.

Specifically, in addition to ISE market data, ISE members must have access to the consolidated data of all options markets, either on the same terminal or available at the same workstation. Moreover, the exemption prohibits the ISE from disseminating its market data directly to its members on a more timely basis than ISE provides it to the consolidated data system under any plan to allocate consolidated systems capacity during peak usage periods. This condition is intended to ensure that the information about

ISE's market that others receive through the consolidated system is as timely as the market information that ISE members receive directly from ISE.

Finally, the Commission notes that it is granting this exemption only to ISE at this time, but would favorably consider identical requests from other options markets (Press Rel 2000-71)

## ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

---

### COMMISSION ISSUES ORDER INSTITUTING PROCEEDINGS AGAINST JOSEPH GALLUZZI

On May 25, the Commission issued an Order Instituting Public Administrative Proceedings against Joseph P. Galluzzi to determine what remedial action, if any, should be taken against him based upon the entry of a final judgment in *SEC v. Galluzzi*, Civ No. 97-96 (D.N.J. October 20, 1999) (injunctive action) and his criminal conviction in *United States v. Joseph P. Galluzzi*, Crim No 96-640 (WHW)(D.N.J.), for numerous counts of mail fraud, wire fraud, and public corruption.

The complaint alleged that between October 1986 and December 1993, Galluzzi received more than \$250,000 in undisclosed kickbacks from First Fidelity Securities Group (FFSG) and A G. Edwards & Sons, Inc ("AGE"). FFSG and AGE paid Galluzzi these kickbacks in connection with their selection as lead underwriter for issuances of municipal securities by Essex County, New Jersey, the Essex County Improvement Authority (ECIA) and the Township of Irvington, New Jersey. FFSG paid Galluzzi at least \$176,296.16 in kickbacks between April 1987 and August 1992 relating to its selection as lead underwriter for Essex County's March 1987, January 1989 and June 1989 bond issues, and for Irvington's 1991 fiscal year adjustment bond anticipation notes and Irvington's 1992 fiscal year adjustment bonds. Pursuant to a sham finder's agreement between Galluzzi and AGE, between March 1991 and December 1993, AGE paid Galluzzi at least \$82,085.82 in kickbacks relating to AGE's selection as lead underwriter on the ECIA's August 1990 \$65 million bond issue.

While he was accepting the kickbacks Galluzzi served as Treasurer to Essex County and as a financial consultant to Irvington, ECIA and the Essex County Board of Chosen Freeholders.

The final judgment in the injunctive action, which was entered on October 20, 1999, after the court granted the Commission's motion for summary judgment, permanently enjoined Galluzzi from violating Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5. On September 10, 1998, in connection with his criminal conviction, Galluzzi was sentenced to 90 months in prison and ordered to pay restitution of \$350,000

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations in the Order are true and what, if any, remedial sanctions against Galluzzi are appropriate (Rel 34-42826, File No 3-10209)

## **DEFAULT JUDGMENT AGAINST FORMER PRESIDENT OF INTERACTIVE MULTIMEDIA PUBLISHERS, INC.**

The Commission announced that on May 5 the Honorable Dan Aaron Polster, United States District Judge for the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, filed a Final Judgment by Default against defendant P. Joseph Vertucci. Vertucci is the former president and chief executive officer of Interactive Multimedia Publishers, Inc (IMP), an Akron, Ohio software development firm. The Final Judgment requires Vertucci to disgorge \$829,990 received by him as a result of his unlawful conduct described in the SEC's complaint, plus prejudgment interest in the amount of \$262,380,89. In addition, the Final Judgment imposes a civil penalty on Vertucci in the amount of \$829,990. The Final Judgment also permanently enjoins Vertucci from violating certain provisions of the federal securities laws and permanently bars him from serving as an officer or director of certain corporations whose securities are registered with the Commission or that are required to file certain reports with the Commission.

The Final Judgment against Vertucci arises from a complaint filed by the SEC on February 24, 1999, in which the Commission charged Vertucci with insider trading, financial fraud and stock price manipulation. Vertucci failed to answer or otherwise respond to the Commission's complaint. The litigation remains pending as to defendants Bruce E. Straughn, Richard M. Johnson, Roland R. Baughman, Robert V. Petry, Edward Meyer, Jr., and Hazlet Investors, Inc, and relief defendant Joanne C. Straughn [SEC v. P. Joseph Vertucci, et al., Civil Action No. 5:99CV426, ND Ohio] (LR-16565)
