ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

SEC SETTLES INSIDER TRADING CASE AGAINST TOMMY GREER, NEDENE GREER, TRACIE CARPIN, AND KIMBERLY DAVIS

On August 17, the Commission filed a settled injunctive action in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia against Tommy Dalton Greer, Nedene Greer, Tracie Carpin, and Kimberly Davis in *SEC v. Tracie Carpin, Kimberly Davis, Nedene Greer and Tommy Dalton Greer*, 00 Civ Action No. 01996. The complaint alleges that in March and May of 1997 Tommy Dalton Greer and members of his family engaged insider trading in the securities of Catalina Marketing Corporation, a Florida marketing company and Inbrand Corporation, formerly a Georgia adult incontinence product manufacturer. At the time of the trading, Greer was a member of the board of directors of Catalina and Inbrand. Without admitting or denying the allegations of the complaint, the defendants consented to the entry of a final judgment permanently enjoining them from violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws [Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5, thereunder], and ordering them to pay disgorgement of unjust enrichment of \$163,750.58 and civil penalties totaling \$161,181.03.

The complaint alleges that prior to Catalina's announcement on March 31, 1997 of disappointing fourth quarter earnings, Greer learned this information and knowingly or recklessly provided to his wife, Nedene Greer, and his two stepdaughters, Tracie Carpin and Kimberly Davis. Nedene Greer, Carpin and Davis each sold or caused to be sold shares of Catalina. In addition, the complaint alleges that Greer learned prior to the May 13, 1997 announcement that Tyco International Ltd. would acquire Inbrand and provided that information knowingly or recklessly to his wife and stepdaughter, each of whom purchased or caused to be purchased shares of Inbrand. The defendants realized unlawful profits and avoided losses of at least \$129,119 from trading while in possession of material nonpublic information about Catalina and Inbrand.

SEC FILES LAWSUIT AGAINST HOUSTON INTERNET STOCK PROMOTION FIRM

The Commission announced that on August 15 it filed a civil complaint against Merger Communications, Inc. and its two owners, Jukka U. Tolonen and David A. Drake of Houston, Texas. The complaint alleges that Merger distributed press releases and other communications via the Internet touting numerous Over The Counter (OTC) and NASDAQ quoted stocks without properly disclosing that the companies compensated Merger.

- Merger Communications, Inc. is a Houston, Texas, based “financial promotion” company.
- Jukka U. Tolonen, age 35, is a citizen of Finland, residing in Houston, Texas, and owner and president of Merger. Tolonen moved to Houston in 1995 to start Merger.
- David A. Drake, age 37, is a resident of Houston, Texas, and executive vice president of Merger.

The SEC alleges that in press releases and mass facsimile and e-mail distributions, Merger distributed highly favorable information concerning the issuers that was intended to create immediate increases in the trading volume and share-price of the issuers’ stock. On its website and in communications with prospective clients, Merger boasted that its services often resulted in immediate increases in volume and share-price appreciation for its clients’ securities. As compensation for its promotional efforts, Merger and its principals received shares of the touted issuer’s stock. The amount of shares received was dependent upon the share price increase during Merger’s promotional efforts.

With respect to many of its touts, Merger did not disclose that its promotional and touting activity was bought and paid for by the company whose stock was being touted and that its investment advice, therefore, was not disinterested. For other touts, Merger disclosed generally that it “may” be compensated in stock or that it was hired by the issuer, but it did not fully disclose the nature and amount of compensation.

The SEC also alleges that Merger’s promotional efforts had the intended effect of increasing the issuer’s stock price. For example, after Merger’s promotion of one OTC stock, PinkMonkey.com, the company’s shares increased 400% in the first two days after the dissemination of Merger’s promotional release. In another instance, shares of another Merger client, Clearworks Technologies, Inc., increased 66% in the three days following Merger’s tout of the company’s stock. Typically, however, the impact of Merger’s efforts was short lived, and the price of its clients’ stock returned to the pre-tout price within a few days.

Merger, Tolonen and Drake, without admitting or denying any of the allegations of the SEC’s complaint, simultaneously agreed to settle the charges that they violated the anti-touting provisions of the federal securities laws. Under terms of the settlement, each of the defendants will be permanently enjoined from future violations of Section 17(b) of the

Securities Act of 1933. In addition, the proposed judgment orders Merger to pay a civil penalty of \$50,000 and Tolonen and Drake to pay a civil penalty of \$10,000 each.

SEC WINS SUMMARY JUDGMENT AGAINST FORMER BROKER LASCOLA

The Commission announced that on June 23, 2000, the United States District Court in Rhode Island granted its Motion for Summary Judgment against Todd J. LaScola. The Court permanently enjoined LaScola from further violations of the general and investment adviser antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The judgment also directs LaScola to pay disgorgement in the amount of \$6,329,825 plus prejudgment interest and pay a civil monetary penalty of \$100,000.

The matter stems from a complaint, the Commission filed on December 29, 1998, alleging that in November 1988 LaScola, the sole owner of CPI Investment Management, Inc. (CPI) and a principal and co-owner of CPA Advisors Network, Inc. (CPA), diverted over \$6 million from client and customer accounts to repay another client, the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW), for improper transactions in the IBEW's pension fund account. The complaint also alleged that LaScola misappropriated \$200,000 from an advisory client.

Immediately upon filing the complaint, the Commission sought and obtained temporary restraining orders and asset freezes against LaScola, CPI and CPA. On January 8, 1999, the Court granted the Commission's motion for preliminary injunctions against LaScola, CPI and CPA. On July 7, 2000, the Court also granted the Commission's motion to dismiss its complaint against CPI, whose corporate had lapsed, and CPA, which is currently controlled by a Securities Investors Protection Corporation Trustee. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW CENTURY ENERGIES, INC., ET AL. NORTHERN STATES POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by New Century Energies, Inc. (NCE), a registered holding company, and Northern States Power Company (NSP), a public utility holding company exempt from registration by order under Section 3(a)(2) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act. NCE and NSP have been authorized to combine their respective utility and nonutility businesses under a new holding company, Xcel Energy Inc. In addition, NSP and NCE have been authorized to engage in various intrasystem transactions. Further, NSP has been authorized to establish its Black Mountain Gas division as a utility subsidiary. (Rel. 35-27212)

CONECTIV, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing Conectiv, a registered holding company, to invest the proceeds of securities issuances in exempt wholesale generators and to issue short-term debt securities. In addition, the order authorizes a nonutility subsidiary of Conectiv to participate in the system money pool. The Commission has reserved jurisdiction over Conectiv's proposal to increase the amount of long-term debt Conectiv is authorized to incur. (Rel. 35-27213)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-99-67) relating to amendments to NASD membership rules. (Rel. 34-43157)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change has been filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-00-36) to extend the pilot fee structure governing the reimbursement of member organizations for costs incurred in the transmission of proxy and other shareholder communication materials and to amend the components of coordination activities. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 21. (Rel. 34-43159)

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-00-39), which amends the Exchange By-Laws relating to the disqualification of members of the Board of Governors and others. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 21. (Rel. 34-43161)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission issued notice of filing and granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-00-16) submitted by the New York Stock Exchange amending the listed company fee schedule under Paragraph 902.02 of the Listed Company Manual to impose a fee cap on total listing fees charged, as a pilot program effective through December 31, 2002. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 21. (Rel. 34-43163)

The Commission issued notice of filing and granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-00-15) submitted by the New York Stock Exchange amending the initial listing fee for tracking stocks under Paragraph 902.02 of the Listed Company Manual. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 21. (Rel. 34-43164)
