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## RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

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### REVISION TO FORM BD ADOPTED

The Commission adopted a revision to Form BD, the registration application form for broker-dealers. The revision adds to the form an explicit consent to service of process provision for actions brought by the Commission or self-regulatory organizations. (Rel. 34-25285)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### JAMES R. BRAMBLE ORDERED TO DISGORGE

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on December 31, 1987 U.S. District Judge Norman C. Roettger, Southern District of Florida, entered an Order directing James R. Bramble to pay disgorgement in the amount of \$5.4 million, representing proceeds obtained pursuant to a scheme involving the fraudulent sale of unregistered securities. The Court had previously entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction.

The Complaint alleged that Bramble had violated the registration and antifraud provisions by selling securities to the public in the form of investment contract interests in stallion/broodmare syndications. Bramble consented to the Final Judgment without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations. The Court also found that Bramble had aided and abetted violations of the broker-dealer registration provisions of the Securities Exchange Act by effecting sales of securities while not registered with the Commission as a broker-dealer. (SEC v. James R. Bramble and Arthur R. Bucci, Civil Action No. 87-6203-CIV-ROETTGER, SDFL). (LR-11650)

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## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

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### STANFORD C. STODDARD SENTENCED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on January 8 Stanford C. Stoddard, former chairman of Michigan National Corporation (MNC), was sentenced by U.S. District Court Judge Anna Diggs Taylor to three years incarceration and fined \$15,000. Stoddard, after a jury trial, was found guilty on August 10, 1987 of misapplying \$175,000 in bank funds, in violation of 18 USC 373 and 656, by overcharging Michigan National Bank, a MNC subsidiary, for rent on a building in which Stoddard had an undisclosed interest. Stoddard was released on a \$15,000 personal bond pending appeal of his conviction.

Stoddard, in an unrelated matter, had on January 24, 1985, simultaneous with the filing by the Commission of a complaint for permanent injunction and other equitable relief, consented to a final judgment of permanent injunction, without admitting or denying the allegations, which alleged violations of the reporting, books and records, and proxy provisions of the Securities Exchange Act [SEC v. Michigan National Corporation, et al., EDMI, S. Div., Civil Action No. 85 CV 703331 DT]. (U.S. v. Stanford C. Stoddard, EDMI, S. Div., 86-80869). (LR-11649)
