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COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

SEC'S NEW YORK OFFICE NAMES CARMEN LAWRENCE AS ASSOCIATE REGIONAL ADMINISTRATOR FOR ENFORCEMENT

Lawrence Iason, Regional Administrator of the SEC's New York office, announced the selection of Carmen Lawrence as the Associate Regional Administrator for Enforcement. In announcing the appointment, Mr. Iason said, "Carmen Lawrence is an outstanding lawyer who has demonstrated exceptional leadership skills. I am confident she will make a major contribution to the office in her new position."

Ms. Lawrence received her undergraduate degree from Cornell and her law degree from the University of Michigan. After law school, Ms. Lawrence spent two years as a staff attorney in the SEC's Division of Enforcement in Washington, D.C., then worked for a brief time for a law firm in New York. Ms. Lawrence joined the SEC's New York office as a staff attorney in June 1984. She became a Special Counsel in November 1985, a Branch Chief in February 1986 and an Assistant Regional Administrator in October 1986. (Press Release 88-30)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ORDER MODIFYING PRIOR ORDER

The Commission ordered that the Order Instituting Proceeding under Sections 15(b)(4) and (6) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Findings, and Order against Jefferies & Company, Inc. and Boyd L. Jefferies, entered on March 19, 1987, be modified, as necessary, to allow Jefferies & Co. until June 1, 1988 to submit the affidavit of compliance required by the Order.

Respondents consented to the Order without admitting or denying the allegations contained therein. The Order, among other things, required Jefferies & Co. to comply with the undertakings contained in its Offer of Settlement. Jefferies & Co. undertook, among other things, to submit to the Commission a report and recommendations of an outside consultant, and an affidavit setting forth the details of its implementation of the recommendations contained in the report. Jefferies & Co., through its Counsel, has requested that the time allowed for the submission of its affidavit to the Commission be extended until July 1, 1988. The Commission determined that it is appropriate to grant Jefferies & Co.'s request. (Rel. 34-25572)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES INTERNATIONAL SWISS INVESTMENTS CORP., OTHERS

The Seattle Regional Office (SRO) filed a Complaint on April 15 in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Washington against International Swiss Investments Corp. (ISI), The Leverage Fund, The Sulfur Fund, Leonard C. Zrnich, and Jana Whyman, all formerly operating out of San Jose, Costa Rica and currently operating out of Panama and Cancun, Mexico. The Complaint alleges that each violated the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and Investment Company Act of 1940, and the antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

According to the Complaint, from the summer of 1986 to the present, defendants conducted a boiler room operation from San Jose, Costa Rica for the offer and sale of ISI common stock and unit investments in the two funds.

The Complaint seeks a temporary restraining order and a preliminary and permanent injunction, an order restraining defendants from disposing of assets which represent investments of U.S. investors of at least \$4,479,900, and order directing an accounting and disgorgement of funds illegally obtained.

Because of the nationwide solicitation not all investors are known to the Commission. Investors who desire more information may contact the SRO, Seattle, Washington (206) 442-7990 or their local Regional Office. (SEC v. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

EDWARD ATKINSON CONVICTED

The Los Angeles Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the Central District of California announced that on March 28 a federal jury found attorney Edward J. Atkinson guilty of perjury in a Commission investigation and of conspiring to file and filing false financial reports with the Commission on behalf of the Video Station, Inc., a Los Angeles company which pioneered the videocassette rental business. Atkinson was secretary/treasurer and a member of the board of directors. His brother George W. Atkinson, formerly president and a director of the company, pleaded guilty before the trial of filing a false Form 10-K and Form 10-Q with the Commission. (U.S. v. Edward J. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF NEW YORK

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 9 to request a hearing on an application filed by the Mutual Life Insurance Company of New York (MONY) and MONY Variable Account-C for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges in connection with the issuance of individual flexible payment variable annuity contracts. THE CHASE MANHATTAN BANK, N.A.

An order has been issued on an application filed by The Chase Manhattan Bank, N.A. to permit it to continue to deposit securities and other assets of U.S. registered management investment companies with Nederlandse Credietbank N.V. (NCB), a banking institution in The Netherlands which does not qualify for an exemption provided by Rule 17f-5, notwithstanding the fact that Chase has transferred its interest in NCB. (Rel. COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY FACILITY LOAN TRUST TWO

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 2 to request a hearing on an application filed by The First National Bank of Boston, not in its individual capacity, but solely as trustee on behalf of the College and University Facility Loan Trust Two, in connection with the Federal government's loan asset sale program. The application requests an order exempting the Trust from the provisions of Sections 10(h), 14(a), 16(a), 17(a), 18(a), (c) and (i), and 32(a) of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of bonds and senior and junior certificates of beneficial interest in the Trust collateralized by certain loans originated by the U.S. Department of Education. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 9 to request a hearing on a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company (National), a registered holding company, and three of its subsidiaries, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, Seneca Resources Corporation, and Empire Exploration, Inc., whereby National will issue and sell, pursuant to an exception from competitive bidding, up to two million shares of its authorized common stock, no par value, and contribute the proceeds to the capital of the subsidiaries.
