NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

Following is a schedule of Commission meetings which will be conducted under provisions of the Government in the Sunshine Act. In general, the Commission expects to follow a schedule of holding closed meetings on Tuesdays, and open meetings on Thursday morning. Meetings on Wednesday, and if necessary on Thursday afternoons, will be either open or closed according to the requirements of agenda items under consideration.

Visitors are welcome at all open meetings, insofar as space is available.

Meetings will be held in the Commission Meeting Room, Room 1C30, at the Commission's headquarters building, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC. Persons wishing to photograph or videotape Commission meetings must obtain permission in advance from the Secretary of the Commission. Persons wishing to tape record a Commission meeting should notify the Secretary's office 48 hours in advance of the meeting.

OPEN MEETING - WEDNESDAY, JUNE 1, 1988 - 10:00 a.m.

The subject matter of the June 1 open meeting will be:

(1) Consideration of a staff report and recommendations concerning the use of predispute arbitration clauses by the securities industry in agreements with its public customers. FOR FURTHER INFORMATION, PLEASE CONTACT Robert Love at (202) 272-3064.

(2) Consideration of possible amendments to Rule 10b-4 (17 CFR 240.10b-4), the short tendering rule, in light of the decision of the Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit in Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith, Inc. v. (3) Consideration of whether to approve a proposed rule change by the New York Stock Exchange that would permit members to install telephone lines at their booth spaces that will enable them to communicate from the Exchange floor with nonmembers located off the floor. (4) Consideration of whether to issue a release for public comment (1) proposed amendments to revise the reporting requirements for issuers changing their fiscal year end; (2) proposed related amendments to Form 8-K; (3) proposed amendments to the accounting and proxy rules relating to financial reporting; and (4) proposed amendments to the quarterly reporting rules. COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

TEMPORARY REGISTRATION OF A CLEARING AGENCY

The Commission approved the temporary registration of the Government Securities Clearing Corporation (GSCC). GSCC plans to provide comparison facilities to government securities brokers and dealers in U.S. Treasury securities, including zero coupon bonds and when-issued securities. The estimated average daily dollar value in U.S. Treasury securities exceeded 110 billion dollars in 1987. The Commission believes the temporary registration of GSCC is a significant step in providing centralized, automated comparison service to this vital market. (Rel. 34-25740)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

RICHARD J. LORENAT, OTHERS ENJOINED

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on May 17 U.S. District Judge Mariana R. Pfaelzer, Central District of California, entered orders permanently enjoining Richard J. Lorenat, Michael Joyce, and Kenneth L. Shattuck from violations of the registration, antifraud, and broker-dealer registration provisions of the securities laws. The Complaint alleged that defendants conducted fraudulent unregistered securities offerings involving investments in commercial real estate. Two corporate defendants, Newport Interstate Properties, Inc. (NIP California) and Newport Interstate Investors, Inc. (NIP Investors) had previously consented to orders permanently enjoining them from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. NIP California is currently in a proceeding under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code and a trustee has been appointed. NIP Investors consented to being placed into a bankruptcy proceeding under Chapter 7 of the Code. All of the defendants consented to the orders without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint. (SEC v. Newport Interstate Properties, Inc., et al., USDC CDCA, Civil Action No. 87 05459 MRP, TX). (LR-11747)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CONNECTICUT YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company, subsidiary of Northeast Utilities and New England Electric System, to issue and sell its Series A general and refunding mortgage bonds in the principal amount of \$100 million, pursuant to an exception from competitive bidding. Connecticut Yankee also proposes to issue approximately \$96 million principal amount of its Series B general and refunding bonds to secure approximately \$96 million of outstanding bank obligations. SAVANNAH ELECTRIC AND POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Savannah Electric and Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to issue and sell up to \$25.5 million of short-term notes outstanding at any one time prior to April 1, 1990. (Rel. 35-24649 - May 24)

EASTERN EDISON COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Eastern Edison Company, Montaup Electric Company, Blackstone Valley Electric Company, and EUA Service Corporation, subsidiaries of Eastern Utilities Associates, whereby Montaup will issue and sell short-term notes in the aggregate principal amount outstanding at any one time not to exceed \$40 million. LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 15 to comment on the application of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in seven issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-87-31) which authorizes specialists to accept market-on-close (MOC) orders and to report executions of certain MOC orders as stopped stock transactions. (Rel. 34-25733); and The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-87-9) to amend Section 19(f) of its Rules of Fair Practice to allow the receipt of performance-based fees under certain circumstances. (Rel. 34-25736)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The following have filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4: The Pacific Clearing Corporation (SR-PCC-88-1) which would reduce the size of its Board of Directors from the current ten to thirteen positions to five to seven positions. (Rel. 34-25741); The Pacific Securities Deposit Trust Corporation (SR-PSDTC-88-1) which would reduce the size of its Board of Directors from the current ten to thirteen positions to five to seven positions. (Rel. 34-25742)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of May 30.

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
