ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ORDER ISSUED AGAINST MEYERS PARKING SYSTEM, INC.

The Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings under Section 15(c)(4) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Findings, Opinion and Order (Order) against Meyers Parking System, Inc. (MPS). The Commission found that MPS failed to comply with Section 13(e) of the Exchange Act and Rule 13e-3 in connection with a merger whose effect was to cause MPS to become a privately-held company. The failure of MPS to comply with Section 13(e) and Rule 13e-3 deprived the company's minority public shareholders of information which was necessary to make a fully informed decision as to whether or not to vote against the merger, abstain or not vote in order to exercise dissenters' rights regarding the merger. MPS consented to the Order without admitting or denying any of the matters set forth in the Opinion and Findings therein. (Rel. 34-26069)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

FINAL JUDGMENTS OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST LOUIS MIRANTI AND EDWARD F. TALBOT

The San Francisco Branch Office announced that U.S. District Judge Lloyd D. George of the District Court of Nevada entered final judgments of permanent injunction against Louis Miranti and Edward F. Talbot. They consented to the injunctions without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint. Both parties are enjoined from future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions. Miranti is further enjoined from aiding and abetting future violations of the issuer-reporting provisions.

The Complaint, filed on September 16, 1986, alleged that Miranti and Talbot were involved in several schemes to misappropriate the common stock of International Teldata Corporation, worth in excess of \$5 million. (SEC v. Charles W. Anshen, et al., Civ. No. CV S-86-862 LDG, DNV). (LR-11862)
