## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

PERMANENT INJUNCTIONS ENTERED  
AGAINST NATIONAL ENERGY DEVELOPMENT, INC., OTHERS

The Denver Regional Office announced that on October 26 the U.S. District Court for the District of Wyoming entered Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction against National Energy Development, Inc., Alan R. Hanesworth, and William M. Wilson, enjoining them from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Defendants consented to the Judgments without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint. The Complaint alleged that defendants had between 1975 and 1987 offered and sold unregistered securities in the form of investment contracts, involving the marketing and mining of coal leases to approximately 450 investors through 25 states, raising approximately \$1.2 million.

[The Wyoming Secretary of State, Securities Division, referred this matter to the Commission and provided substantial assistance in the investigation.] (SEC v. National Energy Development, Inc., et al., USDC WY, Civil Action No. C-88-0096-B). (LR-11907)

## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

JOHN MCCURDY, SR. PLEADS GUILTY

George Phillips, U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of Mississippi, the U.S. Postal Inspection Service, and the Commission announced that on November 9 John McCurdy, Sr. pleaded guilty to one count of mail fraud, one count of securities fraud, and one count of sale of unregistered securities. McCurdy's plea related to material misrepresentations and omissions made in connection with the sale and offer for sale of unregistered oil and gas working interests asserted in the Commission's action against McCurdy and others in SEC v. Petro-Serve, Ltd., et al., filed on July 23, 1987. (U.S. v. John McCurdy, Sr., Criminal No. S 88-00046 G, SDMS). (LR-11908)

UBZ CORPORATION

An order has been issued declaring that UBZ Corporation has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16627 - Nov. 8)

AMERICAN SKANDIA LIFE ASSURANCE CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 5 to request a hearing on an application filed by American Skandia Life Assurance Corporation, Skandia Life Variable Account C, and Skandia Life Equity Sales Corporation for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Account. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
