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## ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

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### HOWARD BOYAR BARRED FROM THE SECURITIES INDUSTRY

The Commission has entered an Order pursuant to Sections 15(b)(6) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Making Findings, and Imposing Sanctions (Order) against Howard Boyar (Boyar). The Order finds that on March 24, the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York entered a Final Judgment of Injunction and Other Relief as to Howard Boyar, permanently enjoining him from violating Section 10(b) and Rule 10b-5 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Previously, on March 18, the Commission filed a complaint alleging that Boyar engaged in insider trading and tipped others while he was in possession of material nonpublic information concerning the securities of eight publicly traded companies. The complaint also alleged that Boyar realized illegal profits of at least \$156,050, and his tippees' illegal profits total at least \$51,881. Finally, according to the Order, between February 1994 and November 1997, Boyar was associated with various broker-dealers registered with the Commission.

Boyar consented to the Order, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, and consented to a bar from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company.

### UPON EMERGENCY MOTION OF THE COMMISSION, COURT FINDS JAMES MICHAEL COGLEY IN CIVIL CONTEMPT FOR VIOLATING PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ORDER

The Commission announced that on March 5 the United States District Court for the Southern District of Ohio found James Michael Cogley (Cogley) in civil contempt for violating provisions of an Order of Preliminary Injunction entered against him by consent on August 18, 1998. On February 24, 1999, the Commission filed an Emergency Motion for an Order to Show Cause why Cogley should not be held in civil contempt for violating a provision of the Preliminary

Injunction specifically prohibiting Cogley from receiving, directly or indirectly, any funds from individuals or entities for the purpose of investment.

The court ordered a civil contempt hearing for March 5, 1999. During the civil contempt hearing, the court found, by clear and convincing evidence, that, among other things, Cogley gave investment advice and received funds from individuals for the purpose of investment, in violation of the Preliminary Injunction. In addition, the court ordered a Criminal Contempt Hearing that is currently scheduled for April 1, 1999. [SEC v. James Michael - Cogley, et al., S.D. OH; No. C2-98-802] (LR-16096)
