COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

COMMISSION AND NASAA ANNOUNCE 1999 CONFERENCE ON FEDERAL-STATE SECURITIES REGULATION AND REQUEST COMMENTS ON THE TENTATIVE AGENDA

The Commission and the North American Securities Administrators Association, Inc. (NASAA) announced that the annual conference on Federal-State Securities Regulation will be held on April 19, 1999. Because participation at the conference is generally limited to Commission and NASAA personnel, the release indicates that interested persons should participate by providing written comments by April 14, 1999.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

INITIAL DECISION ISSUED IN HUDSON TERENCE COXON, ET AL.

Chief Administrative Law Judge Brenda P. Murray has issued an initial decision in which she concluded that Terence M. Coxon, Alan M. Sergy, and World Money Managers (WMM) willfully violated Section 206(2) of the Investment Advisers Act, Sections 10(b), 12(b), 13(a)(3), 17(d), and 34(b) of the Investment Company Act, Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder.

Mr. Coxon is a general partner of WMM. WMM is investment adviser to the Permanent Portfolio Family of Funds, Inc. (Fund) of which Mr. Coxon is president and a director. Mr. Sergy is a limited partner of WMM and treasurer and a director of the Fund. The bases for Respondents' alleged violations of the federal securities laws were that, inter alia, Mr. Coxon, Mr. Sergy, and WMM crossed the line between proper and improper conduct by making material misrepresentations and omissions, and engaging in self-dealing transactions.

Chief Judge Murray determined that it was in the public interest to issue a cease and desist order against all of the Respondents; to suspend Mr. Coxon and Mr. Sergy from association with any investment adviser and investment company for a period of three months; to suspend the registration of WMM for a period of three months, to order that WMM, Mr. Coxon, and Mr. Sergy disgorge \$1,608,018, and prejudgment interest of \$1,236,726, and to assess second tier civil penalties of \$100,000, \$20,000, and \$20,000 against WMM, Mr. Coxon, and Mr. Sergy, respectively. PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST CHARLES WESSMAN

The Commission has entered an Order Instituting Public Cease and Desist Proceedings Pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Charles E. Wessman (Wessman), a San Bernardino, California accountant. In the Order, the Division of Enforcement alleges that Wessman prepared and disseminated financial statements and accompanying audit or compilation reports for Intercontinental Resources N.A., Inc. (IRC) for fiscal years 1994, 1995, and 1996, as well as for the period ended March 31, 1997. The Division contends that the financial statements Wessman prepared for IRC were misleading in that they failed to conform with generally accepted accounting principles in several respects. According to the Division, the financial statements Wessman prepared overstated IRC's assets, understated IRC's liabilities, and falsely stated that IRC had revenues. The Division alleges that, by these actions, Wessman violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and that he caused IRC's violations of the same provisions.

A hearing will be held before an administrative law judge to determine whether the staff's allegations are true and, if so, to determine whether a cease and desist order should be issued against Wessman. (Rels. 33-7665; 34-41239; AAE Rel. 1120; File No. 3-9861)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST KPMG AUDIT PARTNER

The Commission has instituted proceedings pursuant to Rule 102(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice against Carroll A. Wallace, CPA, audit engagement partner with KPMG Peat Marwick, LLP in its Denver office. The Commission alleges that Wallace did not conduct the audits of the 1994 and 1995 financial statements of the Rockies Fund, Inc. (Fund) in accordance with Generally Accepted Auditing Standards (GAAS) in that he failed to adequately plan the audits; obtain sufficient competent evidential matter concerning the procedures and bases for the valuation by the Fund's board of directors of certain stock held by the Fund; and failed to maintain an attitude of professional skepticism by ignoring indications that the Fund's valuations of the stock were inflated and by failing to appropriately question representations made to the auditors by the Fund's management. Finally, the Order alleges that Wallace engaged in improper professional conduct by failing to assure that the

Fund's financial statements complied with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) in that the Fund's 1994 and 1995 financial statements materially overstated net assets due to the improper classification of the stock described above.

A hearing will be held before an administrative law judge to determine whether the staff's allegations are true, and if so, whether Wallace should be censured or temporarily or permanently disqualified from, and denied the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Commission. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST FORMER AUDITORS OF SKY SCIENTIFIC, INC.

The Commission has instituted proceedings pursuant to Rule 102(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice against Barry C. Scutillo, CPA, and Mark F. Jensen, CPA. The Commission alleges that Scutillo and Jensen, the engagement partner and concurring partner, respectively, for the 1994 audit of Sky Scientific, Inc., (Sky) failed to comply with Generally Accepted Auditing Standards (GAAS) in that they failed to plan or perform appropriate audit procedures to audit phony Russian CDs held by Sky which the company valued at \$40 million and its mineral properties which the company baselessly valued at \$29.5 million; failed to maintain control over the confirmation request and response process concerning the CDs; failed to obtain sufficient competent evidential matter concerning the validity and valuation of the CDs, the valuation of the mineral properties and the value of Sky's issuances of millions of shares of Form S-8 stock. Finally, the Order alleges that Scutillo and Jensen engaged in improper professional conduct by failing to assure that Sky's financial statements complied with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles concerning the CDs, the mineral properties and the Form S-8 stock.

A hearing will be held before an administrative law judge to determine whether the staff's allegations are true, and if so, whether Scutillo and/or Jensen should be censured or temporarily or permanently disqualified from, and denied the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Commission.
