CYNTHIA FORNELLI NAMED DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF INVESTMENT MANAGEMENT

Chairman Arthur Levitt today named Cynthia M Fornelli Deputy Director of the Commission's Division of Investment Management As Deputy Director, Ms Fornelli will continue as a key advisor to the Director of the Division and will play an important role in the management of the Division

Chairman Levitt said, "Cindy is a highly articulate and thoughtful lawyer, with the judgment and knowledge to be an excellent Deputy Director I know that investors and the Commission will benefit from her pragmatic approach to investment management issues."

Paul Roye, Director of the Division of Investment Management, said, "I have come to rely on Cindy's insights and judgment during her tenure at the Commission She is an important asset to the Division and her appointment to Deputy Director is well-deserved"

Ms. Fornelli has been an attorney with the Division of Investment Management since June 1999. Most recently she served as Senior Adviser to Mr. Roye. Prior to joining the Commission, she practiced securities law, specializing in investment management issues, first at Fried, Frank, Harris, Shriver and Jacobson from 1991-1997, then at Dechert Price and Rhoads from 1997-1999. While with Fried, Frank, Ms. Fornelli represented investment advisers and broker-dealers in their regulatory matters. At Dechert, she represented a number of investment advisers, broker-dealers and investment companies, becoming an expert at developing and maintaining effective compliance programs.

Ms. Fornelli graduated with high honors from the George Washington University Law Center. She holds a B.A. from Purdue University. (Press Rel. 2001-11)

DAVID SMITH, JR. NAMED ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR (PUBLIC UTILITY AND INVESTMENT COMPANY REGULATION) OF THE DIVISION OF INVESTMENT MANAGEMENT

Chairman Arthur Levitt today named David B. Smith, Jr., Associate Director (Public Utility and Investment Company Regulation) of the Commission's Division of Investment Management. As Associate Director, Mr. Smith will evaluate applications for exemption from the Investment Company Act of 1940 and its rules, and oversee the activities of registered and exempt utility holding companies under the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935, among other duties.

Chairman Levitt said, "David has been a valued attorney in the Commission for a number of years. I know the Division of Investment Management will benefit from his judgment and acumen."

Paul Roye, Director of the Division of Investment Management, said, "David is a thoughtful and able attorney with whom I have had the pleasure of working during my tenure as Director. David's understanding of the Investment Company Act and the Public Utility Holding Company Act is matched by his outstanding ability to deal with colleagues."

Since 1998, Mr. Smith has served as the Assistant General Counsel for Investment Management with the Commission's Office of the General Counsel. Prior to that, he was a staff attorney, then Senior Counsel, with the same Office. Prior to joining the Commission in 1996, Mr. Smith was an associate in the law firm of Shea & Gardner, focusing on corporate and litigation issues.

Mr. Smith, 34, graduated *magna cum laude* from Harvard Law School, earned his M.A. from the University of Chicago, and received his B.A. from Carleton College. (Press Rel. 2001-12)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PAINWEBBER PACE SELECT ADVISORS TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 5, 2001, to request a hearing on an application filed by PaineWebber PACE Select Advisors Trust and Mitchell Hutchins Asset Management, Inc for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act to amend a prior order that granted an exemption from Section 15(a) of the Act and Rule 18f-2 under the Act. The order would permit applicants to enter into and materially amend sub-advisory contracts without receiving shareholder approval. (Rel IC-24823 – January 11)

COVA SERIES TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 2, 2001, to request a hearing on an application filed by Cova Series Trust (CST), Securities First Trust (SFT), Met Investors Series Trust (MIT), Cova Financial Services Life Insurance Company, Cova Financial Life Insurance Company, Security First Life Insurance Company and Firststar Investment Research & Management Company, LLC for an order, pursuant to Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act, granting an exemption from the provisions of Section 17(a) of the Act to permit certain series of MIT to acquire all of the assets and liabilities of CST and SFT. Because of certain affiliations, applicants may not rely on Rule 17a-8 under the Act. (Rel IC-24824 – January 11)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

UNITIL CORPORATION, ET AL.

A supplemental notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 2, 2001, to request a hearing on a proposal by Unitil Corporation (Unitil), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary companies, Concord Electric Company, Exeter & Hampton Electric Company, Fitchburg Gas and Electric Light (Fitchburg), Unitil Power Corp., Unitil Realty Corp., Unitil Resources, Inc and Unitil Services Corp. (collectively Applicants). Applicants seek approval, through June 30, 2003, to increase Unitil's short-term borrowing authority to \$45 million and to increase Fitchburg's short-term borrowing authority to \$30 million.
