COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ANITA NAGLER PROMOTED TO ASSISTANT REGIONAL ADMINISTRATOR

William D. Goldsberry, Regional Administrator, Chicago Regional Office, announced the promotion of Anita Nagler from Chief, Branch of Enforcement, to Assistant Regional Administrator.

Ms. Nagler graduated from the University of Illinois in 1977 with a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work and graduated from the Chicago-Kent College of Law in 1980 with a Juris Doctorate Degree. After graduating, she joined the Chicago Regional Office staff as an attorney in one of the branches of enforcement. She later transferred to the Los Angeles Regional Office where she was promoted to Chief, Branch of Enforcement. In June 1984, she transferred back to the Chicago Regional Office as a Special Counsel and in September 1984 was named chief of one of the enforcement branches.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PRUDENTIAL-BACHE GLOBAL FUND, INC.

CHRISTIANIA CAPITAL CORPORATION

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 10 to request a hearing on a proposal by Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to acquire, by lease or purchase, up to an aggregate of 600 aluminum coal hopper railroad cars prior to December 31, 1986 for use in transporting coal by unit train to coal-fired generating plants owned and/or operated by Georgia. APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed under Rule 19b-4 by The Chicago Board Options Exchange and the American, New York, Pacific and Philadelphia Stock Exchanges. The proposed rule changes (SR-CBOE-84-28, SR-Amex-84-33, SR-NYSE-84-35, SR-PSE-85-19 and SR-Phlx-85-18) permit escrow receipts collateralized by cash, cash equivalents and/or one or more securities to be used as cover, in lieu of margin, for short call positions in broad-based stock index options. (Rel. 34-22323)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

PEOPLE EXPRESS AIRLINES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 4 to request a hearing on an application by People Express Airlines, Inc. under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939.
