ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

AMERICAN VENTURE SECURITIES, INC., OTHERS CITED

The New York Regional Office announced that in administrative proceedings ordered under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, American Venture Securities, Inc. (Registrant), Robert J. Gallaro and Carl Caserta, Registrant's president and vice-president, respectively, have submitted Offers of Settlement, which the Commission accepted. Registrant, Gallaro and Caserta, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to Findings and Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions which finds that they wilfully violated various antifraud provisions of the securities laws, and that Gallaro and Caserta wilfully aided and abetted Registrant's violations of other antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act, and the net capital, bookkeeping and reporting provisions of the Exchange Act.

The Commission revoked Registrant's registration as a broker or dealer, and suspended Gallaro and Caserta, for six months, from association in any capacity with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer. Additionally, the Commission barred, with a right to reapply after two years, Gallaro and Caserta from association with any of those entities in any proprietary or supervisory capacity. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

E.F. HUTTON & COMPANY INC.

An order has been issued amending an earlier Commission order dated May 2, 1985 (Rel. IC-14499) filed by E.F. Hutton & Company Inc. and The E.F. AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. filed an amendment to a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NYSE-85-17) that would set forth certain interpretations and procedures in customer account transfers among its member firms. (Rel. 34-22557)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed rule change which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (SR-Phlx-85-27) to clarify its floor procedures advices concerning trading volume requirements for registered options traders (ROTs) and responsibilities of ROTs for mismatched trades and of floor brokers for missed orders. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of November 4. (Rel. 34-22560)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

CITICORP

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 25 to request a hearing on applications filed by Citicorp under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The applications declare that the trusteeship of The United States Trust Company of New York under four existing indentures, and a pooling and servicing agreement dated August 1 under which certificates evidencing interests in a pool of mortgage loans have been issued, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify the Trust Company from acting as trustee. The Trust Company currently is acting as trustee under the following four indentures dated: (1) February 15, 1972, involving the issuance of floating rate notes, due 1989; (2) March 15, 1977, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes; (3) August 25, 1977, involving the issuance of rising-rate notes, Series A; and (4) April 21, 1980, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes.
