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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### SEC NAMES CONTRACTOR FOR EDGAR SYSTEM

On January 3, the Commission awarded a contract to build the Commission's electronic data gathering, analysis and retrieval (EDGAR) system. The contract was awarded to the BDM Corporation, bidding with Mead Data Central, Inc., Sorg, Inc., and Bechtel Information Systems. The contract has an expected term of eight years. The initial three years will be on a cost reimbursement plus fixed fee basis; the last five years will be fixed price. The total cost to the government over the term of the contract is estimated to be approximately \$52 million. System development will begin shortly, with phase-in of all filers expected to be completed by early 1993. (Press Release 89-1)

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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### BRUCE H. FROST SANCTIONED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Bruce H. Frost, an attorney, formerly of Spokane, Washington. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Frost's Offer of Settlement in which he was permanently denied the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Commission.

The proceedings were based on a finding that Frost had been enjoined in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Washington from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions [Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Sections 10(b) and 15(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5] in connection with the securities of Colonial International Import, Ltd., Tri-Lite Corporation, and Computime Computer Services, Inc. The Court further ordered Frost to disgorge \$2,500. (Rel. 33-6813)

### MANAGED ADVISORY SERVICES, INC. AND HENRY L. CHIESA SANCTIONED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under Sections 203(e) and 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 against Managed Advisory Services, Inc. (MASI), a registered investment adviser, and Henry L. Chiesa, its president, a director, and its majority stockholder. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted MASI's and Chiesa's Offer of Settlement in which, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, they consented to an Order censuring them, prohibiting them from soliciting or accepting clients for 45 days, requiring them to send a copy of the Commission's Order to clients, and ordering that they comply with certain undertakings designed to insure future compliance with the Advisers Act.

In the Order, the Commission found that MASI and Chiesa willfully violated Section 206(4) of the Advisers Act and Rule 206(4)-1(a)(5) by distributing an advertisement containing untrue statements of material fact and which was otherwise false and misleading because it failed to disclose the true results of the application of MASI's timing signals to certain fund combinations, failed to deduct advisory fees when presenting MASI's performance figures, and misstated MASI's hypothetical performance with an unnamed mutual fund combination. **SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST AMERICAN INVESTORS OF PITTSBURGH, INC.  
AND PRINCIPALS**

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against American Investors of Pittsburgh, Inc. (AIP), a Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania broker-dealer, and its principals, John J. Bruno, John W. Mendicino, and Charles Krzywicki. The Commission simultaneously accepted their Offers of Settlement in which they consented, without admitting or denying the findings, to an Order Making Findings and Imposing Sanctions.

In its Order, the Commission made findings that AIP, Bruno, Mendicino and Krzywicki were convicted in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania of, among other things, one count of conspiracy and 47 counts of failing to file Currency Transaction Reports [U.S. v. American Investors of Pittsburgh, Inc., 87-096]. The Commission found that their convictions related to their activities in the conduct of a brokerage business in which the individuals concealed the receipt by AIP of large amounts of cash and failed to file Currency Transaction Reports upon the receipt of cash totalling approximately \$2.3 million.

The Order revokes AIP's registration as a broker-dealer and bars Bruno, Medicino, and Krzywicki from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company, or investment adviser. (Rel. 34-26393)

**PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST OSCAR GOMEZ**

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Oscar Gomez, formerly a director and registered representative of a registered broker-dealer.

The Order for Proceedings alleges (1) Gomez misappropriated customers' funds intended for investment in interest bearing managed trading accounts and government securities between June 1985 and May 1985, in violation of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act; (2) Gomez aided and abetted violations by the broker-dealer of the broker-dealer books and records provisions of the Exchange Act; and (3) on June 20, 1988 a final judgment of permanent injunction was issued against Gomez in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida, permanently enjoining him from violating the antifraud provisions of the securities laws and the broker-dealer books and records provisions of the Exchange Act [SEC v. Michael W. Rehtorik and Oscar Gomez, Case No. 88-0735-CIV-HOEVELER, SDFL].

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Gomez are true and, if so, what, if any, remedial sanctions are appropriate. (Rel. 34-26394)

**SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST JOHN WESLEY GEORGE, JR., OTHERS**

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against John Wesley George, Jr., a/k/a Jaime George, and Heritage Financial Corporation, a Lutherville, Maryland broker-dealer, and under Section 203(e) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 against Capital Concepts of Maryland, Inc., a Lutherville investment adviser. The Commission simultaneously accepted their Offers of Settlement in which they consented, without admitting or denying the findings, to an Order Making Findings and Imposing Sanctions.

In its Order, the Commission found that George willfully violated the antifraud and registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act in connection with seven separate securities offerings between December 1980 and April 1988. George raised approximately \$4 million from investors and converted approximately \$2.8 million for his personal and business use. It also found that Capital Concepts and Heritage willfully violated, and George aided and abetted violations of, the Exchange and Advisers Acts recordkeeping provisions by refusing to permit Commission staff to examine books and records.

The Order bars George from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company, or investment adviser; revokes Capital Concept's registration as an investment adviser; and revokes Heritage's registration as a broker-dealer. (Rel. 34-26396)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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FS GOVERNMENT SECURITIES INCOME FUND, INC.;  
AMERICAN CAPITAL LIMITED MATURITY GOVERNMENT FUND, INC.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until January 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by FS Government Securities Income Fund, Inc. (formerly Yes Fund, Inc.); and American Capital Limited Maturity Government Fund, Inc. for an order declaring that they have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-16722 - Dec. 28, 1988; IC-16724 - Dec. 29, 1988)

### FREEDOM VARIABLE ANNUITY FUNDS

An order has been issued declaring that Freedom Variable Annuity Funds has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16723 - Dec. 29, 1988)

### SCUDDER CALIFORNIA TAX FREE FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 20 to request a hearing on an application filed by Scudder California Tax Free Fund, et al. (Applicants) for an order exempting them from the provisions of Section 32(a)(1) of the Investment Company Act to permit them to file financial statements signed or certified by an independent public accountant selected at a board of directors/trustees meeting held within 90 days before or after the beginning of such Applicant's fiscal year. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### AEP GENERATING COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by AEP Generating Company and its parent, American Electric Power Company, Inc., whereby AEP Generating proposes to issue and sell up to \$650 million of unsecured promissory notes through December 31, 1992, and the two companies propose to execute, deliver, and perform a new Capital Funds Agreement to replace the existing agreement. (Rel. 35-24794 - Dec. 28, 1988)

### NEW ENGLAND ENERGY INCORPORATED

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing New England Energy Incorporated (NEEI), subsidiary of New England Electric System, to contribute up to \$30 million to its Partnership with Samedan Oil Corporation, subsidiary of Noble Affiliates, Inc., during 1989 for exploration and development of oil and gas prospects initiated prior to December 31, 1986. Jurisdiction has been reserved over an additional contribution by NEEI to the Partnership during 1989 in the amount of \$10 million. (Rel. 35-24795 - Dec. 29, 1988)

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change which has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-NSCC-88-12) imposes a fee for NSCC's NETWORKING service. (Rel. 34-26404)

### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-88-53) that would amend Article VIII, Section 5 of its By-Laws. The proposal would provide that any vacancy created by the departure of District Business Conduct Committee (DBCC) members during their terms may be filled by appointment by the remaining DBCC members until the next regularly scheduled election. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of January 1. (Rel. 34-26407)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-88-37) to implement for a one-year period auxiliary closing procedures to handle order flow during monthly expirations of stock index derivative products, (Rel. 34-26408)

**ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES**

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.

Below is a list of recent filings of Schedules 13D and 14D, which includes the following information: Column 1 - the company purchased (top), and the name of the purchaser; Column 2 - the type of security purchased; Column 3 - the type of form filed; Column 4 - the date the transaction occurred; Column 5 - the current number of shares (in 000's) owned (top) and the current percent owned; Column 6 - the CUSIP number (top) and the prior percent owned; and Column 7 - the status of the filing, i.e., new, update or revision.
