RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

AMENDMENTS TO VARIOUS RULES, FORMS, AND THE CODIFICATION OF FINANCIAL REPORTING POLICIES

The Commission is publishing for public comment certain amendments to its rules and forms to reflect recent changes in generally accepted accounting principles established under newly adopted Statements of Financial Accounting Standards. In this proposing release, the Commission is also approving certain changes to the Codification of Financial Reporting Policies to conform with the newly adopted standards.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

APPEAL OF TARA SECURITIES CORP. AND LAWRENCE J. GOLLIN DISMISSED AS MOOT

The Commission dismissed as moot an appeal from NASD action by the brokerage firm of Tara Securities Corporation, of Sunrise, Florida, and Lawrence J. Gollin, a principal of that firm. On the basis of an injunction entered against Gollin, the NASD refused to permit his continued association with the firm. In dismissing the appeal, the Commission noted that, in an unrelated action, the NASD had cancelled Tara's NASD membership, rendering the question of Gollin's continued association with the firm moot. The Commission also vacated the NASD decision appealed from, and directed the NASD to dismiss the proceedings that led to that decision. (Rel. 34-26537)

STOP ORDER PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST CTI TECHNICAL, INC.

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under Section 8(d) of the Securities Act of 1933 against CTI Technical, Inc. A hearing has been scheduled to determine whether the allegations in the Division of Enforcement's Statement of Matters are true and whether a Stop Order suspending the effectiveness of CTI's registration statement should be issued.

The Statement of Matters alleges that CTI failed to cooperate, or obstructed or refused to permit the Division of Enforcement's examination under Section 8(e). It further alleges that CTI's registration statement, as amended, included untrue statements of material facts concerning, among other things, its officers and directors, its principal shareholders, the beneficial ownership of its securities, the control of the issuer, the plan of distribution, and its intent regarding an acquisition. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES AUTOSPA CORPORATION AND AUTOSPA AUTOMALLS, INC.

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on February 16 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against AutoSpa Corporation (AC) and AutoSpa Automalls, Inc. (AAI) of Great Neck, New York.

The Commission alleges in its Complaint that AC and AAI, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file their Annual Reports on Form 10-K for their fiscal years ended June 30, 1988, and their Quarterly Reports on Form 10-Q for their fiscal quarters ended September 30 and December 31, 1988. AC also failed to file seven Notifications of Late Filing on Form 12b-25 with respect to its delinquent periodic reports and two Current Reports on Form 8-K. AAI failed to file three Notifications of Late Filing regarding its acquisitions of significant assets. The Commission is seeking an order requiring AC and AAI to file their delinquent Annual and Quarterly Reports and AC to file its delinquent Current Reports, and enjoining them from further violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws. (SEC v. AutoSpa Corporation and AutoSpa Automalls, Inc., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 89-0424, CRR). (LR-11998)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE GUARDIAN INSURANCE AND ANNUITY COMPANY, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 9 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Guardian Insurance and Annuity Company, Inc., Guardian Investor Services Corporation, and Guardian Separate Account C, for an order exempting them from the provisions of Sections 26(a), 27(a)(1), and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(1), 6e-2(b)(13), and 6e-2(c)(4) to permit the (1) use of the 1980 CSO Table rather than the 1958 CSO Table in calculating the cost of insurance deduction; (2) deduction of the cost of insurance charge from the investment base; and (3) Account to hold shares of the underlying mutual funds under an open account arrangement. METRO PORTFOLIO INVESTOR'S STOCK FUND

An order has been issued to permit the proposed acquisition by Fidelity Trend Fund of substantially all of the assets of Metro Portfolio Investor's Stock Fund. (Rel. IC-16813 - Feb. 14)

AMERICAN CAPITAL PRIME SERIES, INC.

An order has been issued declaring that American Capital Prime Series, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16814 - Feb. 15)

UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Midwest Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-MSE-88-8) that would add to its Certificate of Incorporation and Constitution a provision exempting members of its Board of Governors from monetary liability to the MSE or its members for breach of fiduciary duty as a governor. Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of February 13. (Rel. 34-26548)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-88-30) that will permanently approve an amendment to Rule 126(g) permitting orders to cross blocks of 25,000 shares or more to have precedence over other bids and offers.
