Wednesday, April 5

- * David S. Ruder, Chairman of the Commission, will testify before the Subcommittee on Commerce, Justice, State, the Judiciary and Related Agencies of the Senate Appropriations Committee. Subject of the hearing is appropriations. Time and place will be announced.

Thursday, April 6

- * David S. Ruder, Chairman of the Commission, will testify before the Securities Subcommittee of the Senate Banking, Housing and Urban Affairs Committee beginning at 10:00 a.m. Subject is the Commission's authorization request, and related oversight issues. The hearing will be in Room 538 of the Dirksen Senate Office Building.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

SUBPOENA ENFORCEMENT ACTION FILED AGAINST DEAN WITTER REYNOLDS, INC.

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on March 27 it instituted a subpoena enforcement action against Dean Witter Reynolds, Inc. (DWR) in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas, Fort Worth Division. The action seeks enforcement of an administrative subpoena *duces tecum* served on DWR. The subpoena calls for the production of DWR's internal audit reports and related documents for its Fort Worth branch office from June 1982 to present. DWR refused to produce the internal audit reports and related documents claiming, among other things, the subpoenaed documents are protected by a "critical self-analysis" privilege. (SEC v. Dean Witter Reynolds, Inc., USDC NDTX, Civil Action No. 4-89-236K). (LR-12047)

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST RANDY GLEICH AND BRENDA KROSS

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on February 2 and March 1 the U.S. District Court for the District of Nevada entered an Order of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief by Consent against Randy Gleich and Brenda Kross, respectively. On February 3, the Commission filed a 12-count Complaint against Gleich, Kross, and others alleging, among other things, violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws in the trading of the securities of Composite Design, Inc. (formerly, SRS Technical, Inc.) and CTI Technical, Inc. (SEC v. Stoneridge Securities, et al., DNV, Civil Action No. CV-S-89-096, PMP). (LR-12048)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

WALTER FRANCIS CURRAN INDICTED

The Boston Regional Office and the Office of the U.S. Attorney announced that Walter Francis Curran of Wellesley, Massachusetts, an account executive formerly employed at the Boston office of Dean Witter Reynolds, Inc., was indicted on March 21 by a grand jury in Boston on 39 counts of mail fraud and one count of bank fraud.

The Indictment alleges that from March 1, 1981 to February 17, 1989, Curran defrauded certain investors of in excess of \$3 million by falsely representing to them that he would invest their money with Dean Witter and then converted the money and used it for his own personal purposes. According to the Indictment, Curran falsely promised the investors their money would earn 20% interest in his account and he provided the investors with false account statements which purported to record their investments. Curran is also accused of defrauding the First National Bank of Boston of \$155,000 in a check kiting scheme. (U.S. v. Walter F. Curran, CR No. 89-65-H). (LR-12046)
