COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

**BRIEF URGES THAT IN PRIVATE ACTIONS UNDER RULE 10b-5,
COURTS APPLY FIVE-YEAR LIMITATIONS PERIOD IN ITSFEA**

Daniel L. Goelzer, General Counsel of the Commission, announced the filing in the United States Supreme Court, in response to the Court's request for the government's views, of a friend-of-the-court brief addressing issues raised in a petition for Supreme Court review in Lebman v. Aktiebolaget Electrolux. The petition seeks review of a decision of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit that a two-year limitations period for claims arising under the Texas general fraud statute governs the petitioners' claims under the antifraud provisions of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5. The brief urges that private claims under Rule 10b-5 should be governed by a five-year statute of limitations drawn from Section 20A of the Exchange Act, added by the Insider Trading and Securities Fraud Enforcement Act of 1988 (ITSFEA). The brief, however, takes the position that the petition should be denied because, among other things, the lower courts have not yet had the opportunity to consider Section 20A as a possible source for a limitations period applicable to claims under Rule 10b-5. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

KEITH S. SHELDON SENTENCED

The U.S. Attorney for the Northern District of Georgia and the Atlanta Regional Office announced that on May 30 Judge William C. O'Kelly sentenced Keith S. Sheldon of Hiawassee, Georgia to one year imprisonment followed by three years of supervised release, a \$2,500 fine, and \$25,050 restitution. Sheldon had previously pled guilty to one count of securities fraud and one count of mail fraud.

The plea charged that from about August 1, 1988 to about October 5, 1988 Sheldon, while employed as a registered representative with R. B. Marich, Inc., solicited in excess of \$25,000 from investors. The plea charges that Sheldon, for the purpose of deceiving and defrauding investors and to induce them to invest, misrepresented and made false statements of material facts, concerning, among other things, that (1) investor funds would be and were used to purchase 3,000 shares of Sea Venture Cruises, Inc. common stock; and (2) the investment in Sea Venture common stock would net a 19.8% return within 30 to 90 days.

The case is the most recent of a number of securities fraud cases successfully prosecuted in the Northern District of Georgia in which the number of victims has ranged from one to over 300 and restitution ordered to be paid in excess of \$4,250,000 to victims. The defendants have included registered representatives, registered investment advisers, and promoters. (U.S. v. Keith S. Sheldon, USDC NDGA, CR-88-21G). (LR-12128)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SCHRODER CAPITAL FUNDS, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 5 to request a hearing on an application filed by Schroder Capital Funds, Inc. (Schroder Capital), Fund Source, Schroder Capital Management International Inc., and Schroder Holdings, Inc.

Applicants have requested an order that would exempt certain transactions from the provisions of Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act. The requested relief would permit two newly created series of Schroder Capital to each acquire the respective assets and liabilities of one of two series of Fund Source, International Equity Trust and Global Bond Trust, in exchange for shares of the applicable series of Schroder Capital, which shares would be distributed in liquidation to the shareholders of the applicable Fund Source series. FREEDOM INVESTMENT TRUST

An order has been issued on an application filed by Freedom Investment Trust amending existing orders to exempt certain current and future series of Applicant from the provisions of Section 22(d) of the Investment Company Act. The order permits an additional waiver of the contingent deferred sales load imposed on certain redemptions by Unitholders of Freedom Income Trust or any future series of Freedom Income Trust whose shares were purchased in connection with the Dividend Reinvestment Program. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ARKANSAS POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Arkansas Power & Light Company, subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to issue and sell, prior to February 28, 1991, up to \$270 million of its first mortgage bonds by competitive bidding procedures, and up to \$150 million of its preferred stock, by negotiated public offering or private placement. Jurisdiction continues to be reserved over certain matters pending completion of the record, and released as to others. (Rel. 35-24901 - June 13)

CNG ENERGY COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Company, a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, CNG Energy Company, whereby the two companies propose to increase their investment arrangements in cogeneration projects from \$100 million up to \$289 million, and to form a single purpose subsidiary to make such additional investments in the Lakewood Project located in Lakewood, New Jersey.
