COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF GUIDANCE OF ACCOUNTING FOR DISCLOSURE OF LDC DEBT RESTRUCTURINGS

The staff of the Commission has made available a letter and memorandum dated July 14, 1989 from the staff to Dr. David C. Mulford, Under Secretary of Treasury, U.S. Department of Treasury, which provides a brief analysis of the accounting and disclosure required in connection with certain proposed adjustments of LDC debt. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

THOMAS E. BERNHOFT, OTHERS ENJOINED

The Seattle Regional Office filed a complaint for injunction on August 24 in the Western District of Washington against Thomas E. Bernhoft and Glenn R. Hadland, both of Tacoma, Washington; Forbes Portfolio Management, an investment adviser owned by Bernhoft; and Forbes Group, Inc. and FPM, Inc., both Washington corporations, for violations of Securities Act registration and Securities Act, Exchange Act, and Advisers Act antifraud provisions in the issuance of securities by Forbes Group, FPM, and Forbes XMI Master Trust. It was alleged that investor funds raised for all investments described were commingled and diverted from the investment purpose represented. Defendants consented to an injunction, an accounting, and restitution. (SEC v. Thomas E. Bernhoft, et al., WDWA, C89-1280). (LR-12241)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

WILLIAM ROBERT METTE' ARRESTED; BOND SET AT \$1 MILLION

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on August 31 William Robert Mette' was arrested by U.S. Marshals following an Order of Arrest issued by U.S. District Judge William J. Castagna, Middle District of Florida. The Order of Arrest was issued on April 12 after Mette' fled to Colombia, S.A., apparently to avoid a hearing pursuant to the Commission's and the U.S. Attorney's Application For An Order To Show Cause Why William Robert Mette' Should Not Be Punished For Criminal Contempt (Application). The Application alleged that Mette' violated a permanent injunction entered against him in SEC v. Belton, et al., Case No. 87-1890-CIV-T-13C, MDFL, by engaging in the offer and sale of securities.

Since April 1989, Mette' has been a fugitive residing in Medellin, Colombia, S.A. Mette' is currently being held in the Hillsborough County Jail. Bond was initially set for \$1 million. A second bond hearing was scheduled for September 6. (U.S. v. William Robert Mette', a/k/a Robert William Mette', Case No. 89-CR-T-15B, MDFL). (LR-12240)

FRANKLIN INVESTMENT TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 2 to request a hearing on an application filed by Franklin Investment Trust and Franklin Valuemark Funds for an order granting an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act to permit the merger of the Trust into Valuemark. WITHDRAWAL SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 27 to comment on the application of LEE PHARMACEUTICALS to withdraw its common stock, \$.10 par value, from listing and registration on the Pacific Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-27225)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

CORRECTION RE NASD PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The August 29th News Digest incorrectly listed the NASD proposed rule change among those that had been filed. In fact, the Commission approved the proposed rule change (SR-NASD-89-24). (Rel. 34-27177)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by: The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-89-27) that established the examination specifications and study outline for the recently approved registration category of Assistant Representative-Order Processing (Series 11). (Rel. 34-27219); and The Cincinnati Stock Exchange (SR-CSE-89-1) to amend Rule 11.9(c) so as to permit its Securities Committee to assign the obligation of guaranteeing public agency order execution to one Designated Dealer in a new National Securities Trading System issue. (Rel. 34-27220)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change has been filed by: The Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-89-18) to permit combination orders which are executed in conjunction with stock orders to have the same priorities as combination orders that do not involve stock transactions and to update its rules with respect to the limit order book to reflect that there are no more Board Brokers on the CBOE. (Rel. 34-27224); and The Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-89-2) to narrow the bid-ask differential for certain options quotations and modify the permissible bid-ask differential provisions for stock options that are in-the-money. (Rel. 34-27223)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of September 11.

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

AMERICAN AIRLINES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 2 to request a hearing on an application by American Airlines, Inc., a Delaware corporation, under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of The Connecticut National Bank under two or more indentures, to be qualified under the Act, and under one or more of such qualified indentures and under certain other indentures previously qualified or not subject to qualification under the Act, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify the Bank from acting as trustee under any of such indenture. All of the indentures relate to leveraged lease transactions involving a lease of aircraft to the Company. (Rel. TI-2220)
