CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST UNIOIL AND WILLIAM M. MULDERIG

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on October 19 U.S. District Judge Thomas P. Jackson entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction granting the Commission's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment that Unioil, aided and abetted by William M. Mulderig, violated Section 13(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 12b-25, 13a-1, and 13a-13 by failing to file required annual and quarterly reports or Notifications of Late Filings with the Commission.

Judge Jackson also entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction by Default on the Commission's remaining allegations as a sanction for defendants' failure to respond to discovery. The Complaint alleged that defendants violated Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act by making misrepresentations and omissions of material fact to influence Unioil's stock price that Unioil's "sober pill" would reduce blood alcohol levels; that Unioil, aided and abetted by Mulderig, violated Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rule 12b-20 by filing a Form 10-K that misrepresented and omitted material facts regarding the "sober pill"; and that Mulderig violated Section 16(a) of the Exchange Act and Rule 16a-1 by failing to report changes in his beneficial ownership of Unioil stock.

The Commission seeks disgorgement by Mulderig. (SEC v. Unioil and William M. Mulderig, Civil Action No. 88-2803 TPJ, DDC). (LR-12289)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

T. ROWE PRICE SPECTRUM FUND INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 24 to request a hearing on an application filed by T. Rowe Price Associates, Inc., et al., for an order to permit the Spectrum Fund to acquire shares of funds within the T. THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P) and Western Massachusetts Electric Company (WMECO), subsidiaries of Northeast Utilities, whereby CL&P and WMECO will substitute a new letter of credit provider to support certain existing repayment obligations in connection with the issuance and sale of pollution control bonds. COLUMBIA FUELS, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing Columbia Fuels, Inc. and its parent company, Alabama Power Company, to finance the purchase of Alabama's nuclear fuel in the approximate amount of up to \$150 million. (Rel. 35-24979 - Oct. 31)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-89-12) to eliminate the requirement that securities eligible for deposit at DTC must be serviced by transfer agents located in the United States and clarify its authority to combine a participant's account positions in the same security issue when determining the extent to which DTC may reverse deliveries to the National Securities Clearing Corporation in the event of a common member default. AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-89-5) that would amend its Board of Governors' Interpretation on Prompt Receipt and Delivery of Securities to require, with certain exceptions, that NASD members make an affirmative determination, before effecting short sales for their own accounts, that the securities will be borrowed or delivered before settlement date.
