INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BANKERS NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by Bankers National Life Insurance Company, Bankers National Variable Account C and BNL Securities, Inc., for an order granting exemptions the provisions of Section 2(a)(35) of the Investment Company Act and paragraphs (b) (1), (b)(13)(i)(B), (c)(2), (c)(4) and (c)(4)(vii) of Rule 6e-3(T), in the issuance of certain flexible premium variable life insurance contracts. (Rel. IC-14882 - Jan. 2)

PARTNERS' GROWTH FUND

An order has been issued on an application filed by Partners' Growth Fund and Partners' Deferral Fund (Funds), amending an existing Commission order [Rel. IC-14444 - April 1, 1985] to permit partners and principals of Coopers & Lybrand to make certain joint investments with the Funds. (Rel. IC-14883 - Jan. 2)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MIDWEST ENERGY COMPANY

An order has been issued approving a proposed transaction whereby Midwest Energy Company would acquire all of the outstanding common stock of Iowa Gas Company. (Rel. 35-23970 - Dec. 30, 1985)

COLUMBIA GAS TRANSMISSION CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation (Transmission), subsidiary of Columbia Gas System, Inc. (Columbia), to issue up to \$800 million of Series C first mortgage bonds to certain Southwest gas producers (Producers). The Producers will simultaneously sell the bonds to a Columbia subsidiary, Producers Settlement Corporation (PSC), under a Bond Purchase and Sale Agreement for \$800 million in settlement of certain of Transmission's high-cost natural gas purchase obligations. Columbia is authorized to guarantee PSC's payments to the Producers. (Rel. 35-23971 - Dec. 30, 1985)

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to finance pollution control facilities in an amount up to \$36.4 million. Jurisdiction has been reserved over additional financing of up to \$113.6 million. (Rel. 35-23972 - Dec. 30, 1985)

CEDAR COAL COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Cedar Coal Company, an indirect subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP), to renovate, rebuild and modify major pieces of mining equipment for AEP system companies and for nonassociate companies. (Rel. 35-23973 - Dec. 31, 1985)

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to issue and sell at competitive bidding up to 10,000,000 shares of common stock from time to time and in varying amounts through March 31, 1987. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-85-34) which would require NASD members to maintain a record of aggregate "short" positions in NASDAQ securities in all customer and proprietary firm accounts and to report such information to the NASD on a monthly basis. Members reports will be non-public, and will be used by the NASD only for an internal study concerning short sales. (Rel. 34-22731)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Securities Depository Trust Company (SR-PSDTC-85-13) amending its schedule of fees and charges for bearer-form municipal securities custody services has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A). The Commission is soliciting comments on the proposed rule change. (Rel. 34-22744)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed by: The Pacific Securities Depository Trust Company (SR-PSDTC-85-12) to codify its procedures for processing complete and partial redemptions of PSDTC eligible securities; and define the limits of PSDTC's liability for missed calls and redemptions. (Rel. 34-22745); and The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated (SR-CBOE-85-46) to establish filing fees in arbitration of Member Controversies and to award damages for the knowing and purposeful failure to pay for floor brokerage services.
