CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL ACTION FILED AGAINST JOSEPH G. CREMONESE

The Commission filed a complaint on January 17 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York against Joseph G. Cremonese. The complaint seeks a permanent injunction restraining and enjoining Cremonese from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and disgorgement of \$11,886, plus interest.

The complaint alleged that: Cremonese was an officer of Fisher Scientific Company, a subsidiary of Allied Corporation; Cremonese was assigned to a task force to study Instrumentation Laboratory, Inc. (IL) as a possible acquisition by Allied after IL publicly announced that it was for sale on January 3, 1983; from January 4 through January 28, 1983, Cremonese misappropriated material, nonpublic information which he obtained in confidence from his employer, Allied, and in breach of his duties to Allied, purchased 1,000 shares of IL's common stock in seven transactions; after Allied's public announcement of its tender offer for IL on January 29, 1983, Cremonese sold these shares at a profit of \$11,886. MONTAUP ELECTRIC COMPANY
