ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

DECISION REVOKING INVESTMENT ADVISER REGISTRATION OF HENDERSON, INC. AND BARRING WILLIAM ORR HENDERSON FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge revoking the investment adviser registration of Henderson, Inc. of Tucson, Arizona, and barring William Orr Henderson, its president and sole shareholder, from association with any investment adviser, has become final.

According to the law judge's decision, from about November 1978 through February 1982, respondents converted to their own use funds that clients had advanced on respondents' representation that the funds would be used to purchase certificates of deposit. In 1984, in connection with the same activities, respondents were convicted of fraud and theft, and consented to a permanent injunction enjoining them from further violations of antifraud provisions. PETER SCOTT GEWANT BARRED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under Section 15(b)(6) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Peter Scott Gewant, an employee of a broker-dealer registered with the Commission. Gewant, while employed by a registered broker-dealer, caused \$199,500 of his employer's customers' funds to be transferred by wire from their brokerage accounts without their permission, authorization or consent and arranged for these transferred funds to be deposited into fraudulent bank accounts that he had established at various New York City banks. Gewant was convicted before the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York of conspiracy and wire fraud.

In anticipation of the Commission barring him from association in any capacity with any broker or dealer, investment company or investment adviser, Gewant submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission accepted. (Rel. 34-22862)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

C. H. BUTCHER, JR. AND JAMES E. STEINER INDICTED

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on February 5 a federal grand jury in Knoxville, Tennessee returned a 26-count indictment against C. H. Butcher, Jr. and James E. Steiner for violations of the mail, wire and securities fraud statutes in connection with the operations of Southern Industrial Banking Corporation (SIBC), which filed for reorganization under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code on March 10, 1983. Butcher was the former chairman of the board of directors and chief executive officer of SIBC and Steiner was president during the relevant time period. The indictment alleges that in the offer and sale to the public of securities by SIBC in the form of notes and passbook accounts, Butcher and Steiner made material misrepresentations to the investors concerning, among other things, the financial condition of SIBC and the use of investors' funds. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

KEMPER INVESTMENT TRUST SERIES I AND SUBSEQUENT SERIES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 11 to request a hearing on an application filed by Bankers Security Life Insurance Society, Bankers Security Variable Life Separate Accounts I and II, registered management investment companies, USLICO Securities Corporation and Bankers Centennial Management Corp. (together, Applicants), for an order exempting them from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(i), 22(c), 22(d), 26(a)(1), 26(a)(2), 27(c)(1), 27(c)(2), 27(f) and 27(h) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(1), (b)(10), (b)(12), (b)(13) and (c), 22c-1 and 27f-1 in the issuance and funding of certain single premium variable life insurance contracts. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by The Columbia Gas System Inc., a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, Big Marsh Oil Company, whereby Columbia will purchase any shares of Big Marsh common stock offered for sale by minority shareholders through August 31, 1986 at a per-share price of \$1,650. EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES

A supplemental order has been issued regarding Eastern Utilities Associates (EUA), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, EUA Service Corporation, authorizing the issuance by the subsidiary of up to an aggregate of \$20 million of notes to banks and EUA outstanding at any one time, capital contributions and/or common stock acquisitions of up to \$5 million by EUA respecting the subsidiary, and the amendment of the intrasystem service contracts. The aggregate amount of the proposed notes, capital contributions and common stock will at no time exceed \$21 million. The subsidiary intends to relocate most of its functions to a new office complex to be built on a 70-acre tract of land in West Bridgewater, Massachusetts. (Rel. 35-24020 - Feb. 18)

UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change of National Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-86-2) became effective on filing under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal modifies NSCC's municipal bond when-issued comparison system to process more effectively syndicate takedown trades. (Rel. 34-22906)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

STORAGE EQUITIES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 10 to request a hearing on an application by Storage Equities, Inc. under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of Trust Services of America, Inc. under a 12th supplemental indenture to an existing indenture dated August 9, 1983, qualified under the Act, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify Trust Services from acting as trustee.
