CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

JACK E. WHITE PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on April 4 Judge H. Franklin Waters, U.S. District Court for the Western District of Arkansas, Ft. Smith Division, entered an order of permanent injunction against Jack E. White, of Van Buren, Arkansas. The order permanently enjoins White from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. White consented to the order without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's January 21, 1985 complaint.

The complaint alleged that, from November 1979 through February 1984, White, along with two other defendants, raised \$9 million from approximately 1,600 investors through the offer and sale of unregistered securities in the form of promissory notes issued by Farmers Co-Op of Arkansas and Oklahoma, Inc., violating the registration and antifraud provisions. It further alleged that of the \$9 million raised, approximately \$6 million was invested in undisclosed and unprofitable loans to White Flame Fuels, Inc., a gasohol company solely owned by White. In addition, the complaint alleged that White misrepresented and omitted to state other material facts in the offer and sale of the promissory notes concerning the Co-Op's financial condition, the use of investor proceeds, the security of the investment, and the rate of return offered by the Co-Op. (SEC v. Jack E. White, et al., USDC NDAK, Ft. Smith Division, CA No. 86-2015). (LR-11066)

ARREST WARRANT ISSUED FOR DAVID KEN YOSHINAGA

The Denver Regional Office announced that on April 10 Chief Judge Sherman G. Finesilver, U.S. District Court for Colorado, issued a warrant for the arrest of David Ken Yoshinaga after adjudging him in civil contempt on April 1. The contempt judgment was issued due to Yoshinaga's failure to turn over \$933,933.15 to the Commission as ordered on April 22, 1985. Yoshinaga was also found in civil contempt for failing to appear as ordered by an Order to Show Cause dated February 5, and by an Amended Order to Show Cause dated February 28.

The arrest warrant was issued after Judge Finesilver imposed the sanction of imprisonment for 90 days or until Yoshinaga comes forward with evidence as to why he cannot comply with the April 22, 1985 Order.

Judge Finesilver also awarded attorney's fees and costs of over \$8,000 to the Commission to be satisfied from monies owed to Yoshinaga by a Denver, Colorado company. (SEC v. Investments Management Co., Inc., et al., Civil Action No. 84-F-901, USDC CO). (LR-11067)
