CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

SECURITIES TRADER ENJOINED

The Seattle Regional Office announced that on April 22 Andrew L. Evans was enjoined by the U.S. District Court at Seattle from violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Evans consented to the injunction without admitting or denying the alleged violations. The complaint alleged that while serving as a member of the board of directors of and as principal market maker for a Bellevue, Washington area corporation whose common stock was traded on NASDAQ, Evans engaged in insider trading when he sold the company's stock while in possession of adverse material nonpublic information. The complaint also alleged that Evans manipulated the market for the stock and engaged in a prohibited transaction by purchasing the stock while engaged in a distribution of it. (SEC v. Andrew L. Evans, Civil Action C86-502). (LR-11076)

FARRISH E. BETTON, OTHERS ENJOINED

The Houston Branch Office announced that on April 15 U.S. District Judge Carl O. Bue, Southern District of Texas, entered an Order of Permanent Injunction against Farrish E. Betton (Betton) of Bellaire, Texas, individually and doing business as Betton & Company Group (Group), F. B. Investment Services, Inc. (FBIS), a registered investment adviser, and Betton & Company, Inc. (B & Co.), a Texas corporation. Group, FBIS and B & Co. are owned and controlled by Betton. The Order, among other things, permanently enjoins the defendants from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The complaint alleges that from December 1980 to the present, the defendants, in the offer and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts and common stock, misrepresented material facts concerning, among other things, the use of proceeds from these sales. The complaint further alleges that the defendants diverted approximately \$1 million from investors, including FBIS clients, for their own use and benefit.

The defendants consented to the Order without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations and agreed that the Order will not preclude the Commission from pursuing its request for an accounting and disgorgement. (SEC v. Farrish E. Betton, et al., Civil Action No. H-86-626, SDTX). (LR-11077)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

FRANKLIN B. BEARD CHARGED IN INFORMATION

The U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of Texas and the Houston Branch Office announced that on April 22 a Criminal Information was filed in the Southern District of Texas charging Franklin B. Beard with two counts of mail fraud and two counts of securities fraud.

On April 12, 1984, the Commission obtained injunctions against Beard along with three of his companies and others enjoining them from future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The defendants consented to the injunctive order without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint.

The Information alleges a scheme and artifice to defraud investors through the offer and sale of limited partnership and joint venture interests in ten oil and gas drilling and enhancement programs located in Texas and Oklahoma. The Information charges that a total of \$6 million was raised from the distribution of the securities, part of which was misapplied and misappropriated.

[The facts upon which the Information is based are the result of an investigation conducted by the U.S. Attorney's Office, the FBI and the staff of the Commission.] (U.S. v. Franklin B. Beard, USDC SDTX, H-86-120). (LR-11078)

MISSISSIPPI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY; MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY; THE NARRAGANSETT ELECTRIC COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until May 19 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies under the same release: Mississippi Power & Light Company, subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to issue and sell notes up to a maximum principal amount of \$75.2 million; Massachusetts Electric Company, subsidiary of New England Electric System, to (1) acquire and retire any or all of its \$25 million of outstanding first mortgage bonds, Series O, (2) issue and sell up to \$25 million of first mortgage bonds, Series P, and (3) increase its short-term borrowings from \$30 million to \$50 million until the sale of the Series P bonds is completed; The Narragansett Electric Company, subsidiary of New England Electric System, to acquire or redeem any or all of its outstanding first mortgage bonds, Series J, N, O and P which aggregate \$73.7 million, and to issue and sell up to \$75 million of new first mortgage bonds. APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-86-6) to conform its Rule G-7(b) to the amended Form U-4. (Rel. 34-23171)

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO PLAN

The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed amendment to its minor rule violation reporting plan subject to Rule 19d-1(c)(2) to include violations of NYSE Rule 412 (customer account transfers). (Rel. 34-23172)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-86-10) to amend Article III, Section 1 of its Rules of Fair Practice to change the guidelines for fees that NASD member firms may charge issuers for forwarding proxy and other materials to the issuer's shareholders.

Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of April 21. (Rel. 34-23173)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
