COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

U.S. - JAPANESE SECURITIES REGULATORY AGENCIES SIGN ACCORD

At a meeting in Washington on May 23, John Shad, Chairman of the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission, and Shunsuke Kishida, Director-General of the Securities Bureau of the Japanese Ministry of Finance, executed a memorandum in which the agencies agree to facilitate each others' requests for surveillance and investigatory information on a case-by-case basis. COMMISSION TO HOLD ROUNDTABLE ON FINANCIAL REPORTING

The Commission will hold a roundtable discussion on Tuesday, June 3, at 2:00 p.m. in the Commission Meeting Room, with representatives of the accounting profession, reporting companies, and other interested parties. Issues to be discussed include, but will not be limited to, differences in expectations of financial reporting and the independent auditor's role, and recent private sector and legislative initiatives concerning financial disclosures and independent auditors. The discussion of these initiatives is expected to focus on the merits of these proposals and any cost benefit considerations. (Press Release 86-35)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Massachusetts Electric Company, subsidiary of New England Electric System, to (1) acquire and retire any or all of its \$25 million of outstanding first mortgage bonds, Series O; (2) issue and sell up to \$25 million of first mortgage bonds, Series P; and (3) increase its short-term borrowings from \$30 million to \$50 million until the sale of the Series P bonds is completed. (Rel. 35-24099 - May 21)

MISSISSIPPI POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Mississippi Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to issue and sell up to \$35 million aggregate principal amount of first mortgage bonds in one or more series, having a maturity of not less than five nor more than 30 years, on or prior to March 31, 1988. The Commission reserves jurisdiction over the issue and sale by Mississippi of \$40 million of its first mortgage bonds and \$10 million of its preferred stock. (Rel. 35-24100 - May 21)

CONNECTICUT YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY

An interim order has been issued concerning a proposal by Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company, subsidiary of Northeast Utilities and of New England Electric System, to enter into a \$100 million Remarketable Eurodollar Credit and Letter of Credit Facility (Facility) that would be arranged with a group of domestic and foreign lenders for a term of five years, with anticipated renewal options. The Facility would be available as either revolving credit or as support credit in the form of an unconditional and irrevocable letter of credit to guarantee the issuance of Connecticut Yankee's commercial paper. This interim order authorizes Connecticut Yankee to retain an investment banking firm to arrange the Facility without resorting to competitive bidding. (Rel. 34-24101 - May 21)

UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 13 to comment on the application of the Boston Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in five issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to strike the common stock, par value \$.25 convertible subordinated debentures, due 4/15/88, and 12-7/8% senior subordinated debentures, due 2/1/99, of ELECTRO AUDIO DYNAMICS, INC. from listing and registration thereon. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED PLAN

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed a proposed plan under Rule 19d-1(c)(2) specifying those uncontested minor rule violations with sanctions not exceeding \$2,500 which would be subject to abbreviated quarterly reporting to the Commission under Rule 19d-1(c)(2). (Rel. 34-23249)

ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL OF ACTION TAKEN BY NASD

The Commission found that the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc.'s May 5 denial of a stay of an NASD subcommittee decision to terminate the NMS designation of ORS Automation, Inc. was in accordance with the applicable provisions of the National Market System Designation Plan. EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A rule change filed by the Philadelphia Depository Trust Company (SR-PHILADEP-86-2) has become effective in accordance with Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposed rule change revises certain fees charged to participants for services provided by PHILADEP. (Rel. 34-23263)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
