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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### PROCEEDING INSTITUTED AGAINST ROBERT DONALD JACKSON

The Commission instituted administrative proceedings against Robert Donald Jackson, an Arvada, Colorado investment adviser. The proceedings alleges that Jackson: (1) violated the antifraud provisions of the Investment Advisers Act by making misrepresentations and failing to disclose information to clients to induce them to invest, by omitting to disclose personal interests in projects he sold to his clients, and by converting clients' funds to his own use; (2) violated the recordkeeping provisions of the Advisers Act by failing to make and keep current books and records relating to his investment advisory business; (3) violated the registration provisions of the Advisers Act by making untrue statements of material facts on his Form ADV and failing to amend the information when it became inaccurate; (4) was permanently enjoined by a Colorado state court [Royce O. Griffin, Securities Commissioner v. Robert Donald Jackson, Sr., Civil Action No. 85CV5621] from violating the broker-dealer registration and antifraud provisions of the Colorado Securities Act of 1981; and (5) was convicted of criminal contempt of the aforementioned injunction by a Colorado state court, and sentenced to 120 days incarceration. A hearing will be scheduled to take evidence on the staff's allegations and to afford Jackson an opportunity to present any defenses. (Rel. IA-1029)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### NORTH ATLANTIC AIRLINES, INC. ENJOINED

The New York Regional Office announced that on July 10 Judge Kevin T. Duffy, U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, entered a Final Consent Judgment of Permanent Injunction against North Atlantic Airlines, Inc., the Vermont-based parent of Air Vermont. The Judgment enjoins North Atlantic from violating the anti-fraud and periodic reporting provisions of the securities laws. The defendant consented to the Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint.

The complaint alleged that between July and September 1983, during a \$2 million public offering of North Atlantic securities, potential investors received a false and misleading prospectus. Specifically, the complaint alleges that the prospectus contained misrepresentations and omissions of material facts concerning, among other things, the intended use of proceeds from the offering and the financial condition of the company. The complaint further alleges that North Atlantic failed to file certain quarterly, annual and other reports with the Commission. Two other defendants, Gene Kazlow and John Porter, had previously consented to permanent injunctions, while the action is continuing against the remaining defendants. (SEC v. North Atlantic Airlines, Inc., et al., 86 Civ. 442, KTD). (LR-11165)

### FUTURESAT INDUSTRIES, INC. ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on July 18 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Futuresat Industries, Inc. of Irving, Texas. The Judgment restrained and enjoined Futuresat from failing to file timely periodic reports and Notifications of Late Filing.

In its April 11 complaint, the Commission alleged that Futuresat, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended October 31, 1985 and its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarter ended January 31, 1986. Futuresat, consenting to the Court's Judgment, admitted that it failed to file or filed late four Annual and eight Quarterly Reports and failed to file ten Notifications of Late Filing. (SEC v. Futuresat Industries, Inc., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 86-0986). (LR-11166)

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### SHELLER-GLOBE PAYSUB, INC.
