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## RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

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### DESIGNATION OF NATIONAL MARKET SYSTEM SECURITIES, PROPOSAL OF RULE AMENDMENTS

The Commission is soliciting comments on proposed amendments to two Commission rules that would result in the designation as National Market System (NMS) Securities of almost all listed securities, as well as the over-the-counter securities that are currently designated NMS Securities, and on proposed companion rule changes filed by the National Association of Securities, Inc.

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### THE LIGHT STREET INCOME FUND, INC.

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### KENTUCKY POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Kentucky Power Company, subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, to issue up to \$35 million principal amount of unsecured, fixed-rate notes to banks or other financial institutions, from time-to-time, through December 31, 1986 under a fixed-rate, term loan agreement. ### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-86-31) to clarify that the definition of "options contract" found in Section 2(e) of Appendix E of its Rules of Fair Practice is identical to the definition of "option" in Article III, Section 33(d) of the Rules. (Rel. 34-23820); and The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-86-36) to adopt on a permanent basis its program respecting use of irrevocable letters of credit for foreign currency option margin. (Rel. 34-23821)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of November 24.

### EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-OCC-86-22) imposes a \$200 monthly access and user fee for dial-up access to OCC's on-line computerized communications service. (Rel. 34-23824)
