ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

NASD ACTION AGAINST WALTER C. NATHAN AFFIRMED

The Commission has affirmed disciplinary action taken by the NASD against Walter C. Nathan of Denver, a registered representative of a former NASD member firm. The NASD censured Nathan, fined him \$5,000, suspended him from association with any member firm for 60 days, and required him to requalify as a registered representative by examination within 90 days.

The Commission found, as had the NASD, that Nathan violated NASD rules by participating in a sale of securities in which customers were guaranteed against loss. In affirming the sanctions imposed by the NASD, the Commission stated: "The observance of just and equitable principles of trade does not permit the use of statements which lead an unwary purchaser to the mistaken belief that his transaction are free of risk." MERITOR MORTGAGE SECURITIES CORPORATION
