TRADING SUSPENDED IN SECURITIES OF SHEPPARD RESOURCES, INC.

The Commission suspended trading of the securities of Sheppard Resources because of a lack of current and accurate information and in view of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things: the management of Sheppard Resources; control of Sheppard Resources; the beneficial ownership of its securities; its financial condition; its assets; and other matters. (Rel. 34-24691)

TRADING SUSPENDED IN SECURITIES OF PILGRIM VENTURE CORPORATION

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of Pilgrim Venture Corporation (Pilgrim Venture), a Florida corporation currently headquartered in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, for the period beginning at 1:00 p.m. (EST) on July 10, 1987, and terminating at 1:00 p.m. (EST) on July 20, 1987. The Commission suspended trading of the securities of Pilgrim Venture because of a lack of current and accurate information and in view of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things: the management of Pilgrim Venture; control of Pilgrim Venture; the beneficial ownership of its securities; its financial condition; its assets; and other matters. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTIVE AND OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF SOUGHT AGAINST MARVIN HAYLE INGRAM

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on June 23, a Complaint was filed in the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California against Marvin Hayle Ingram, alleging violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Complaint alleges that Ingram, a registered representative employed with a registered broker-dealer, communicated to two of his clients material, nonpublic information concerning an acquisition of Tauran Industries by Specialized Systems, Inc. (SSI). The Complaint alleges that during February 1985, Ingram established a confidential, insider relationship with SSI and its president, through which he attended acquisition negotiation meetings with representatives of Tauran and SSI. During this period, Ingram disclosed to two of his clients specific information concerning the pending acquisition negotiations. The clients purchased a total of at least 23,000 shares of SSI common stock from Ingram from which he earned at least \$1150 in commissions. Although neither of the clients sold their SSI stock at a profit, if they had sold their shares after SSI's public announcement, they would have gained a total of \$8170 in profits. The Commission is seeking in its Complaint the entry of an Order of Permanent Injunction, the disgorgement of commissions earned and profits that could have been gained as a result of the transactions of the two clients, and ITSA penalties. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

KIDDER, PEABODY & CO., INC.; MORGAN STANLEY & CO., INC.;
SHEARSON LEHMAN BROTHERS INC.

Separate orders have been issued on applications filed by Kidder, Peabody & Co., Inc., Morgan Stanley & Co., Inc., and Shearson Lehman Brothers, Inc. granting an exemption from all provisions of the 1940 Act permitting them to issue "stripped" certificates evidencing interests in the principal or interest payments due on certain bonds held in the custody of a major commercial bank. STONE STREET FUND 1984

An order has been issued on an application filed by Stone Street Fund 1984 and Stone Street Corp., pursuant to Section 6(b) and 6(e) of the Act amending a prior Commission order of exemption from all provisions of the Act with certain exceptions to permit investments through a joint brokerage account. PNPP FUNDING CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by PNPP Funding Corporation for an order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with PNPP's issuance of bonds to facilitate certain leveraged lease transactions. UNITED INVESTORS LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 3 to request a hearing on an application by United Investors Life Insurance Company (United Investors), United Investors Annuity Variable Account (Variable Account), and United Investors Equity Services, Inc. (collectively, Applicants), for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(35), 26(a)(2)(C), and 27(c)(2), to the extent set forth in the application. The order would permit a sales expense charge to be deducted from the assets of the Variable Account on each of the first ten contract anniversary dates, and the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Variable Account. MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.; LOUISIANA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY;
MISSISSIPPI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until July 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24420, dated July 2: Middle South Utilities, Inc. (MSU) - a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Mississippi Power & Light Company (MP&L) and System Energy Resources, Inc. (SERI), whereby MSU and SERI will guarantee certain potential obligations of MP&L, up to an aggregate of approximately \$377.5 million, to refund rates to consumers in Mississippi, pending a final decision on appeal to the United States Supreme Court of a decision of the Mississippi Supreme Court; Louisiana Power & Light Company - subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to amend its nuclear fuel leasing agreement, and to consent to a related credit agreement; and Mississippi Power & Light Company - subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to issue and sell up to \$75 million of its first mortgage bonds by negotiated public offerings or private placements with institutional investors.

THE NARRAGANSETT ELECTRIC COMPANY; CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY;
JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until August 3 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24421, dated July 9: The Narragansett Electric Company - an electric utility subsidiary of New England Electric System, a registered holding company, to issue and sell by competitive bidding through December 31, 1988 one or more series of first mortgage bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$75 million. Narragansett may later seek an exception from Rule 50 to offer the first mortgage bonds on a negotiated basis; Central Power and Light Company - an electric utility subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to \$100 million of debentures by December 31, 1988. The proceeds of the offering are to be used to finance current construction projects and purchase outstanding securities; and Jersey Central Power & Light Company (JCP&L), Metropolitan Edison Company (Met-Ed) and Pennsylvania Electric Company (Penelec) - subsidiaries of General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company, and their wholly owned subsidiary, Saxton Nuclear Experimental Corporation (SNEC). JCP&L, Met-Ed and Penelec have been authorized to collect revenues from their ratepayers for deposit in trust for the decommissioning and dismantling of SNEC's retired nuclear facility. SNEC proposes to withdraw from such trust such amounts that may be necessary to pay the costs of decommissioning and dismantling.

CLEARFIELD OHIO HOLDINGS, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing Clearfield Ohio Holdings, Inc., an exempt holding company, to acquire all of the common stock of Pike Natural Gas Company, an Ohio gas utility company. (Rel. 35-24422)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the New York Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-NYSE-87-19), to apply the listing requirements for warrants under new ¶703.15 of the NYSE Listed Company Manual to the listing of foreign currency warrants. (Rel. 34-24687)

NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Depository Trust Company, (SR-DTC-87-04), to establish the Same-Day Funds Settlement (SDFS) Service for certain types of securities that settle in same-day funds (SDFS securities). The SDFS Service, among other things, will provide full depository and transaction settlement services for SDFS securities. Publication of the Order is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of July 13. (Rel. 34-24689)

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE
