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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### SEC ANNOUNCES AGENDA AND PARTICIPANTS IN PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING VOTING RIGHTS REQUIREMENTS FOR LISTED COMPANIES

The Commission today announced the participants and agenda for its public hearing on proposed Rule 19c-4 regarding voting rights standards for companies listed on national securities exchanges or quoted on the National Association of Securities Dealers Automated Quotation system. The public hearing will be held on July 22 in the Commission's Public Meeting Room, Room 1C30, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC, beginning at 9:15 a.m. (Press Release 87-43)

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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### NASD ACTION AGAINST ROBERT S.C. PETERSON, INC. AND ROBERT S.C. PETERSON AFFIRMED

The Commission affirmed disciplinary action taken by the NASD against Robert S.C. Peterson, Inc., an Excelsior, Minnesota brokerage firm, and Robert S.C. Peterson, its president. The firm and Peterson were censured and fined \$5,000, jointly and severally. In addition, the firm was cautioned with respect to certain of its violations.

The Commission found, as had the NASD, that in 1982 and 1983 the firm and Peterson failed to comply with recordkeeping, reporting, and net capital requirements. The Commission also affirmed NASD findings that, in 1983, the firm violated the NASD's free-riding interpretation and improperly prepaid a subordinated loan without obtaining the NASD's prior written approval. 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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### ALBERT TATE AND SALVATORE DIPIETRO ENJOINED

The Commission today filed a Complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida seeking injunctive and other relief against Albert Tate and Salvatore DiPietro for violations of antifraud and certain filing provisions of the securities laws. Without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint, Tate and DiPietro consented to permanent injunctions and to pay approximately \$86,000, which will be distributed in accordance with a plan to be devised by the Commission and approved by the Court. The Court further ordered Tate to report, on Forms 4, his ownership of Sensormatic stock from November 1982 through January 1984.

The Complaint alleges that Tate, a Vice President of Sensormatic, communicated material, nonpublic information to DiPietro concerning Sensormatic's adverse financial results for its third fiscal quarter of 1984. After such disclosure, DiPietro sold and sold short Sensormatic stock prior to the Company's negative earnings announcement. The Complaint also alleges that DiPietro passed along the information he received from Tate to certain of his friends or advised them to trade.

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### THE PENN MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued granting The Penn Mutual Life Insurance Company, Penn Mutual Variable Life Account I, and Penn Mutual Equity Services, Inc. exemptions from Sections 2(a)(32), 22(c), 27(c)(1), and 27(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-3(T)(b)(12)(ii), 6e-3(T)(b)(13)(iv), and 22c-1 to permit the uncollected portion of the periodic charge made for premium taxes incurred in connection with the issuance of the Contract to be deducted from the amount otherwise payable upon surrender of the Contract during the first nine contract years. ### COLLEGE RETIREMENT EQUITIES FUND

### AETNA LIFE INSURANCE AND ANNUITY COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 5 to request a hearing on an application by Aetna Life Insurance and Annuity Company (Aetna), Variable Annuity Accounts B and C of Aetna Life Insurance and Annuity Company, and Aetna Guaranteed Equity Trust (Applicants), for an order exempting and approving, to the extent necessary, the proposed payment to Aetna of a fee from the assets of two of its separate accounts in return for an investment portfolio performance guarantee offered by Aetna under certain variable annuity contracts and to permit Applicants to participate jointly in the operation of the proposed guarantee. 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## TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

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### CSX CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 3 to request a hearing on an application by CSX Corporation and Sea-Land Service, Inc. under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of Bankers Trust Company under three indentures relating to three separate leveraged lease transactions is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify the Trust Company from acting as trustee under the indentures.
