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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### RICHARD BOLTON SANCTIONED

The Commission today instituted public administrative proceedings against Richard Bolton under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Exchange Act. Simultaneously, Bolton submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission accepted.

The Commission found that Bolton was enjoined from violations of the antifraud provisions of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) and 15(c)(1) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 15c1-2, and the securities registration provisions of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act. The Commission ordered that Bolton be barred from association with any regulated entity with the proviso that he may apply for reassociation after four years. (Rel. 34-24958)

### F.N. WOLF & CO., INC. SANCTIONED

The Commission today instituted public administrative proceedings against F.N. Wolf & Co., Inc. under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Simultaneously, F.N. Wolf submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission accepted.

The Commission found that F.N. Wolf willfully violated the securities registration provisions of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act and failed to supervise adequately Richard Bolton, a person then associated with it. The Commission censured F.N. Wolf and ordered that it comply with its undertakings to retain a special review person to conduct a review of its procedures relating to market making, supervision of personnel and other matters, and to refrain from participating in certain market making activities for 90 days. ## BUNKER SECURITIES CORPORATION AND BRIAN CLENDENIN SANCTIONED

The Commission today instituted public administrative proceedings against Bunker Securities Corporation and Brian Clendenin under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Simultaneously, Bunker and Clendenin submitted Offers of Settlement which the Commission accepted.

The Commission found that Bunker willfully violated the securities registration provisions of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act and the antifraud provisions of Section 15(c)(2) of the Exchange Act and Rule 15c2-11. The Commission censured Bunker and ordered that should Bunker recommence operations in the future, it shall comply with its undertakings.

The Commission found that Clendenin willfully violated the securities registration provisions of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act and aided and abetted Bunker's violations of the antifraud provisions of Section 15(c)(2) of the Exchange Act and Rule 15c2-11. The Commission ordered that Clendenin be suspended from association with any regulated entity for 30 days. In addition, Clendenin agreed to reimburse certain of Bunker's customers for their Medical Dispensing stock losses. (Rel. 34-24960)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### MEDICAL DISPENSING SYSTEMS, INC., NORTHEAST, OTHERS ENJOINED

The Commission filed a Complaint on September 29 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia seeking injunctive relief against Medical Dispensing Systems, Inc., Northeast, Michael L. Allred, Lee Walker, Frank Vitale, Richard Bolton, Henry Pitchford, Burton Vishno, and Delevan Goodhue. Several of the defendants consented to the Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction enjoining Walker, Vitale, Vishno, Pitchford, and Medical Dispensing, variously, from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and the Securities Exchange Act, and the securities registration provisions of the Securities Act. In addition, Bolton consented to a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction enjoining him from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and the Exchange Act, and Section 15(c)(1) of the Exchange Act and Rule 15c1-2, and the securities registration provisions of the Securities Act.

Walker and Vitale also consented to Court Orders that they disgorge \$47,136.90 and \$22,185.00, respectively.

In a related matter, Lee Walker also agreed to plead guilty to one count of criminal contempt of a permanent injunction entered against him in SEC v. Murdock, Civil Action No. 83-777 (D. Co. Amended Complaint filed June 2, 1983). (SEC v. Medical Dispensing Systems, Inc., Northeast, et al., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 87-2664). (LR-11563)

### M.J. COEN ORDERED TO COMPLY WITH COMMISSION ORDER

The Commission today filed in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia of a civil action seeking a court order against M.J. Coen directing compliance with the Commission's order in In the Matter of M.J. Coen [Rel. 34-12608, July 8, 1976], which barred him from association with any securities broker or dealer. The Commission alleges in the complaint that Coen violated the above-cited Commission order by becoming associated with a broker-dealer. Without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint, Coen consented to the Order Directing Compliance with the Order of the Commission. (SEC v. M.J. Coen, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 87-2675). (LR-11564)

BCC and Garton were named as respondents by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (NASD) in an administrative proceeding arising out of the circumstances underlying the Commission's action against Coen. BCC and Garton have submitted offers of settlement to the NASD.

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### SHEARSON LEHMAN SPECIAL EQUITY PORTFOLIOS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by Shearson Lehman Special Equity Portfolios for an order amending an existing order (Rel. IC-14999, March 18, 1986) to permit the waiver of a contingent deferred sales charge in certain circumstances. (Rel. IC-16007 - Sept. 28)

### AIG LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by AIG Life Insurance Company Variable Account I and American International Fund Distributors, Inc. for an order granting exemptions from Sections 26(a) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of Mortality and Expense Risk Charges in connection with the issuance of individual single purchase payment deferred variable annuity contracts. ### CRITERION SPECIAL SERIES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 21 to request a hearing on an application filed by Criterion Special Series, Inc. (CSS), Criterion Bond Fund, Criterion Income Trust, Criterion Special Equity Portfolios, Criterion Technology Fund, Current Interest, Inc., Pilot Fund, Inc., Sunbelt Growth Fund, Inc., The Tax Free Fund, Inc. (Funds), and Criterion Distributors, Inc. (CDI), (collectively with the Funds, Applicants).
