RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

COMMENTS REQUESTED ON PROPOSED RULES 13e-2 AND 14d-11

The Commission yesterday released for public comment proposed Rules 13e-2 and 14d-11 which would require that, subject to certain exceptions, transactions in securities which would result in any person increasing his ownership by ten percent or more of a class of securities once a tender offer has commenced for such class of securities and until ten business days after the scheduled expiration date of the tender offer, be conducted pursuant to the statutory provisions and rules applicable to tender offers. The restriction would apply to target companies, bidders and third parties. The proposed rules would subject bidders to similar requirements, and exceptions thereto, from the time a bidder commences a tender offer solely by means of public announcement until either it formally commences by other means or 30 business days have expired since the bidder has withdrawn such public announcement.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST FORMER OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS OF THE VIDEO STATION, INC.

The Los Angeles Regional Office filed a Complaint on September 24 against George W. Atkinson, former president and director of The Video Station, Inc., a publicly-held company based in Canoga Park, California, Edward J. Atkinson, former secretary/treasurer and director of Video Station, and Keith Bjelajac, former chief financial officer of Video Station. The Complaint alleges violations of the antifraud and reporting provisions and seeks disgorgement by E. Atkinson of approximately \$65,000, representing the loss avoided by his sale of Video Station stock while in possession of material non-public information. It also alleges violations during 1982 and 1983 respecting the reporting of the company's tax liability, inventory, accounts receivable, and accounts payable. (SEC v. George W. Atkinson, et al., CDCA, Civil Action No. 87-06391 KN). (LR-11567)

CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST TEXSCAN CORPORATION, OTHERS

The Los Angeles Regional Office filed a Complaint on September 28 seeking orders permanently enjoining Texscan Corporation, and James A. Luksch, Steven R. McGill, Robert W. Deakin, former president and director, treasurer, and controller, respectively, of Texscan, Norman A. Westcott, Robert J. Palle, Jr., former officers of Texscan, and Daniel F. Litterski, former officer and director of Texscan, from further violations of the antifraud, reporting, and books and records provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The Complaint alleges violations with respect to the reporting of Texscan's total assets, inventories, revenues, net income, and disagreements with its independent auditors during the company's fiscal years 1984 and 1985. It also seeks disgorgement and ITSA penalties against Luksch, McGill, and Palle based on losses avoided from sales of Texscan stock while in possession of material nonpublic information concerning Texscan's true financial condition. Texscan consented to an order permanently enjoining it from violations of the charged provisions. The Commission's action remains pending against the other defendants. (SEC v. Texscan Corporation, et al., USDC DAZ, Civil Action No. 87-1541-PHX-RGS). (LR-11568)

THE STANGER PARTNERSHIP FUND, L.P.

An order has been issued declaring that the independent general partners of The Stanger Partnership are not "interested persons" of the Partnership solely by reason of being general partners thereof. (Rel. IC-16014 - Sept. 29)

ICN PHARMACEUTICALS, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by ICN Pharmaceutical, Inc. for an order declaring it not to be an investment company or, in the alternative, for an order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act and rules and regulations thereunder until July 23, 1988. A temporary order has also been issued exempting ICN from all provisions of the Act until a final determination is made on the application. (Rel. IC-16015 - Sept. 29)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COLUMBIA FUELS, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Columbia Fuels, Inc. and its parent, Alabama Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to increase their nuclear fuel financing arrangements by up to \$20 million. (Rel. 35-24468 - Sept. 30)
