COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

STAFF ACCOUNTING BULLETIN NO. 71A

Staff Accounting Bulletin No. 71 (SAB 71), which was released on August 12, expressed the staff's views regarding the requirements for financial statements of properties securing mortgage loans. Since the issuance of SAB 71, the staff has received inquiries about its position concerning (1) determining the adequacy of the borrower's equity in the underlying property; (2) the financial statements to be included for loan arrangements reported as investments in real estate in filings under the Securities Act of 1933, and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934; and (3) the application of SAB 71 to loans entered into prior to the date of its issuance. This staff accounting bulletin addresses these issues. (Rel. SAB 71A)

MISSISSIPPI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY; ATLEE M. KOHL; CONNECTICUT YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until January 4, 1988 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24523, dated December 10: MISSISSIPPI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY - subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to establish a General and Refunding Mortgage in order to issue and sell up to \$150 million principal amount of an initial series of its general and refunding bonds, by negotiated public offerings or private placements with institutional investors; ATLEE M. KOHL - an individual, that he be permitted to acquire, indirectly, common stock of Great Falls Gas Company, a gas utility company, in such amounts that he will control more than 5% but less than 10% of Great Falls' common stock; and CONNECTICUT YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY - subsidiary of Northeast Utilities and of New England Electric System, and of other New England electric utilities (collectively, Sponsors),

to amend the Indenture pursuant to which its Series A 17% Sinking Fund Debentures, due 1996, were issued. The amendment, which would exclude from the definition of "event of default" certain events or conditions, including bankruptcy, as they may apply to a Sponsor which has severally guaranteed 6% or less of the Debentures, is being proposed following statements by Public Service Company of New Hampshire, a Sponsor guarantor, that it may become the subject of bankruptcy proceedings. The amendment would require the consent of holders of 66 2/3% of the outstanding Debentures.

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

M.D.C. ASSET INVESTORS FUNDING CORPORATION

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
