NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF SECURITIES EXCHANGE ACT RELEASE NO. 34-30571

On April 10, 1992, the Commission adopted Rule 3a51-1 and Rules 15g-1 through 15g-6 (Rules) and issued Securities Exchange Act Release No. 34-30571. The Commission withdrew Release No. 34-30571 prior to its publication in the Federal Register and replaced it with Securities Exchange Act Release No. 34-30608, which was published in the Federal Register at 57 FR 18004 (April 28, 1992). Release No. 34-30608 supersedes Release No. 34-30571 and should be referred to in connection with the Rules. (Rel. 34-30571A)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

MAXIMILIAN DE CLARA ORDERED TO CEASE AND DESIST

On May 6, the Commission issued an Order Instituting Cease and Desist Proceedings under Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Findings and Order against Maximilian de Clara (de Clara). The order requires de Clara to permanently cease and desist from committing or causing any violation of, or any future violation of, Section 16(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 16a-2 and 16a-3 promulgated thereunder. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted de Clara's Offer of Settlement in which, without admitting or denying the matters set forth in the Order, de Clara consented to its issuance.

The Order finds that since 1983, de Clara of Obwalden, Switzerland has been President and a Director of Cel-Sci Corporation (Cel-Sci), a Colorado corporation with headquarters in Alexandria, Virginia. It also finds that from August 1988 through June 19, 1991, de Clara filed late sixteen Forms 4 for his sales of 2,324,222 shares of Cel-Sci stock totalling over \$2.6 million from two to thirty-one weeks late in violation of Section 16(a) of the Exchange Act and the rules thereunder. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CHARLES HOWARD ENJOINED

On April 8, 1992, the U.S. District Court for the District of New Hampshire permanently enjoined Charles H. Howard, III (Howard) from violating Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The complaint alleged that Howard, a former investment banker for Suffield Savings Bank of Suffield, Connecticut (Suffield), misappropriated material non-public information regarding the proposed 1986 merger of Suffield and Coastal Savings Bank of Portland, Maine (Coastal). The complaint charged that Howard improperly disclosed non-public information relating to Suffield's proposed merger with Coastal to a business associate, who then purchased Coastal stock, later realizing an unlawful profit of \$21,407.95. [SEC v. Charles H. Howard, III, Civil No. C-91-288-L, District of New Hampshire] (LR-13235)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SHORT-TERM WORLD INCOME PORTFOLIO, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 1, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by Short-Term World Income Portfolio, et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The order would exempt applicants from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Act and Rule 12d3-1 thereunder. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit them to invest in equity and convertible debt securities of foreign issuers engaged in securities related activities in accordance with the conditions of the proposed amendments to Rule 12d3-1. (Rel. IC-18689; International Series Rel. 381 - May 5)

NUVEEN MUNICIPAL BOND FUND, INC., ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Sections 6(c) and 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder to permit the operation of a joint trading account for the purpose of investing in tax-exempt daily variable rate demand notes. (Rel. IC-18690 - May 5)

WINTERWOOD FUNDS, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 1, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by Winterwood Funds, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18691 - May 5)

COLONIAL ADVANCED STRATEGIES GOLD TRUST, ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Colonial Advanced Strategies Gold Trust, et al. from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The conditional order permits certain open-end management investment companies to issue three separate classes of shares representing interests in the same portfolio of securities, one of which will convert into another class with a lower Rule 12b-1 distribution fee after a specified period. The conditional order also permits certain open-end management investment companies to assess and, under certain circumstances, waive a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of shares of one class. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTHEAST UTILITIES, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Northeast Utilities (Northeast), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary companies, Western Massachusetts Electric Company, The Quinnehtuk Company, The Connecticut Light and Power Company, Northeast Utilities Service Company, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company, The Rocky River Realty Company and Holyoke Water Power Company (collectively, Subsidiaries), and Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH) and North Atlantic Energy Corporation (North Atlantic), both companies authorized to become subsidiaries of Northeast (HCAR Nos. 25221 and 25273, December 21, 1990 and March 15, 1991, respectively) (Orders) (all companies collectively, Applicants). The Applicants propose to add PSNH and North Atlantic, through December 31, 1992, as participants in the Northeast system money pool (Money Pool). PSNH's and North Atlantic's borrowings from the Money Pool will not exceed \$125 million and \$65 million, respectively. The Applicants request that the participation of PSNH and North Atlantic in the Money Pool become effective on the day on which the merger of PSNH, under New Hampshire law, with a newly created, wholly-owned subsidiary of Northeast, named Northeast Utilities Acquisition Corp., becomes effective (as authorized by the Orders). SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-92-08) to revise its schedule of listing fees for bonds and other fixed income debt securities has become effective immediately upon filing with the Commission. (Rel. 34-30663)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-92-05) to modify CBOE's rules governing the addition of new strike prices for stock index options. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-30668)
