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TRADING SUSPENSIONS

U.S. SECURITIES
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

SINGLE TEN-DAY SUSPENSION OF OVER-THE-COUNTER TRADING IN THE SECURITIES OF PROGRAMMING & SYSTEMS, INC.

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of Programming & Systems, Inc. for the period beginning at 9:30 a.m. (EDT) on June 17, 1992 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on July 1, 1992. The Commission suspended trading in the securities of Programming & Systems, Inc. in view of information the Commission has received that the most recently filed annual financial statements of the company, for its fiscal year ended February 28, 1991, substantially and materially overstate the company's income. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL ACTION AGAINST BASSAM HAJE, ET AL.

The Commission announced that on June 3 the Honorable Howell W. Melton, U.S. District Judge for the Middle District of Florida entered a Temporary Restraining Order against Bassam Haje (Haje), Steven Nygaard (Nygaard) and Comtel of Virginia, Inc. (Comtel-Virginia) and a Freeze of Assets against Haje and Comtel-Virginia.

The Commission's complaint alleges that from at least May 1987, and continuing to the present, defendants Haje, Nygaard, Richard Babayan, Ronald DiCara and Jay Werner have fraudulently offered and sold securities in the form of interests in public pay telephone sale-leaseback contracts through various companies doing business as Comtel, including Comtel-Virginia, in violation of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act). The complaint also alleges the defendants made false and misleading statements, including misrepresenting the riskiness of the investments and omitted to disclose material facts, including the Ponzi scheme nature of the investment program and the arrest of several of Comtel-Virginia's directors, in violation of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. A hearing was scheduled for June 12, 1992 to show cause why a preliminary injunction should not be granted. [SEC v. Bassam Haje, et al., Civil Action No. 92-510-CIV-MELTON] (LR-13272)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PRIME FINANCIAL FUNDS, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 7, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by Prime Financial Funds, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18781 - June 12)

CITIBANK, N.A.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act on an application by Citibank, N.A. granting a conditional exemption from Section 17(f) of the Act. The order amends the conditions of certain existing orders so as to modify the custody arrangements required by such orders and, in addition, permits Citibank to maintain custody of the securities of registered investment companies with certain foreign subsidiaries of Citicorp, its bank holding company parent. MORGAN STANLEY EMERGING MARKETS FUND, INC. ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 7, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by Morgan Stanley Emerging Markets Fund, Inc., The Brazilian Investment Fund, Inc., The Malaysia Fund, Inc., The Turkish Investment Fund, Inc., the Morgan Stanley Institutional Fund, Inc. and The Latin American Discovery Fund, Inc. (Funds). The application is for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting the Funds from the prohibitions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Act to the extent necessary to allow the Funds to acquire securities of foreign issuers engaged in securities-related activities, provided such investments comply with the provisions of the proposed amendments to Rule 12d3-1 under the Act. (Rel. IC-18783; International Series Rel. 400 - June 12)

T. ROWE PRICE NEW INCOME FUND, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 10, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by T. Rowe Price New Income Fund, Inc., et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting certain applicants from the provisions of Section 15(f)(1)(A). The order would permit the sponsor/adviser of three funds to receive consideration in connection with the sale of its funds' assets to three T. Rowe Price funds. Without the requested exemption, the three T. Rowe Price funds would have to reconstitute their boards of directors to meet the 75% disinterested director requirement of Section 15(f)(1)(A). (Rel. RENAISSANCE FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 10, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by Renaissance Fund, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18785 - June 15)

NEW YORK VENTURE FUND, ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder to permit New York Venture Fund, et al. to operate a joint trading account for the purpose of investment in repurchase agreements. (IC-18786 - June 16)

CITIUS-BETA FUND, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Citius-Beta Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. In addition, an erratum has been issued correcting the file number under which the notice of the application was published. (Rel. IC-18787 - June 16)

CITIUS-GAMMA FUND, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Citius-Gamma Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18788 - June 16)

PREMIER INCOME FUND

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that the Premier Income Fund has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18789 - June 16)

NUVEEN CALIFORNIA PERFORMANCE PLUS MUNICIPAL FUND, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Nuveen California Performance Plus Municipal Fund, Inc., et al. under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The order permits applicants to distribute capital gains to holders of shares of their preferred stock more frequently than permitted by Section 19(b) of the Act and Rule 19b-1 thereunder when necessary to comply with certain provisions of the Internal Revenue Code. (Rel. IC-18790 - June 16)

NORTH DAKOTA DOUBLE TAX-EXEMPT BOND FUND, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that North Dakota Double Tax-Exempt Bond Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18791 - June 17)

GEICO TAX-ADVANTAGED SERIES TRUST

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that GEICO Tax-Advantaged Series Trust has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18792 - June 17)

MONARCH INVESTMENT SERIES TRUST

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Monarch Investment Series Trust has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18793 - June 17)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PSI RESOURCES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 1, 1992 to request a hearing on a proposal by PSI Resources, Inc. (PSI), an Indiana public-utility holding company exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(1) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act pursuant to Rule 2, and PSI Energy, Inc. (PSI Energy), its sole wholly owned public-utility subsidiary company. PSI and PSI Energy propose to acquire an interest in an Argentine public-utility company that will distribute electric power to approximately one-half of the city of Buenos Aires and the surrounding area. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-92-2) filed by the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board that amends Board Rule G-3 concerning professional qualifications of various participants in the municipal securities market. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 15. (Rel. 34-30798)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-92-09) filed by the American Stock Exchange to establish a cabinet system for certain equity and derivative securities. (Rel. 34-30803)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL ON A TEMPORARY BASIS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved on an accelerated basis until December 31, 1992 a proposed rule change (SR-PTC-92-07) filed by the Participants Trust Company that will allow PTC to designate as securities eligible for deposit with PTC certain securities guaranteed by the Veterans Administration (VA). Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 15. (Rel. 34-30792)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-92-21) that became effective immediately upon filing with the Commission. The proposed rule change amends Section 1(d) of Schedule A to the NASD By-Laws to increase the amount of the credit that each member receives against the amount of its annual assessment on gross income, from 50 percent to 59 percent, and to apply the credit to the entire calendar year 1992. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 15. (Rel. 34-30804)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
