COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

AMENDMENTS TO FORM BD

The Commission is adopting amendments to Form BD, the uniform application form for broker-dealer registration. The amendments make certain technical changes and add a definition of the term "proceeding" to Item 7, the disciplinary background provision of the Form. These amendments, as well as the amendments adopted in Release 34-30958 (July 27, 1992), become effective on November 16, 1992. FOR FURTHER INFORMATION CONTACT: Belinda Blaine at (202) 504-2418. RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

PROPOSED RULES AND REQUEST FOR COMMENT

The Commission has issued a release requesting comment on proposed amendments to Rules 7, 26, 27, 29, 40(a)(5), 41(c), 42(b), 43(b), 44(b), 49, 62, 63, 65(b)(2), 71(b) and 83(d) under the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 (Act) [15 U.S.C. 79 et seq.] and Forms U5S, U-12(I)-A, U-12(I)-B and U-13-60, and the proposed rescission of Rule 50. The proposals are intended generally to modernize the rules under the Act and, in particular, to reduce undue regulatory burdens on companies in a registered holding company system. The amendments would also broaden the exemption from regulation for companies that are primarily engaged in nonutility businesses.

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT RELEASES

ORDER AFFIRMING DENIAL OF ACCESS

The General Counsel affirmed the decision, pursuant to FOIA Exemption 7(A), 5 U.S.C.A. Section 552(b)(7)(A) (West Supp. 1992), 17 C.F.R. Section 200.80(b)(7)(i)(A) (1992), to withhold information from requester John T. Crawford relating to the Commission's

investigation of International Communications Specialists, Inc. The General Counsel concluded that, with the exception of certain public documents, the release of the requested documents could reasonably be expected to interfere with law enforcement proceedings, and thus, were protected under Exemption 7(A). CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

JOAN KANTOR AND FSG FINANCIAL SERVICES, INC. PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on October 14, 1992 a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief (Final Judgment) was entered against FSG Financial Services, Inc. (FSG) and its President, Joan S. Kantor (Kantor). The Final Judgment provides that FSG and Kantor are permanently enjoined from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws, orders that Kantor disgorge \$490,000 and FSG disgorge \$20 million, payment of which is waived against Kantor and partially waived against FSG. The Final Judgment also notes the appropriateness of civil penalties against the defendants.

The Commission's complaint in this matter filed on July 23, 1991 alleged that FSG and Kantor engaged in the fraudulent offer and sale of securities misrepresented to be municipal bonds. On that date, the Honorable James M. Ideman, United States District Judge for the Central District of California, issued a temporary restraining order, an asset freeze, appointed a temporary receiver and ordered other relief. A preliminary injunction against FSG and Kantor was issued on July 29, 1991.

On May 11, 1992, Kantor pleaded guilty to a three-count Information charging her with securities fraud and filing a false tax return. Sentencing is scheduled for November 18, 1992. [SEC v. FSG Financial Services, Inc. and Joan S. Kantor, Civil Action No. 91-3960 JMI, JRx, C.D. Cal.] (LR-13422)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

GORDON BANGERTER IS SENTENCED

The Commission and the U.S. Attorney for the District of Utah announced that on October 19, 1992 Gordon K. Bangerter (Bangerter) of Salt Lake City, Utah was sentenced by District Court Judge J. Thomas Greene to spend one year on probation and to pay a fine of \$5,000.00.

On August 19, 1992, Bangerter pleaded guilty to a one-count misdemeanor information that charged him with having willfully caused a broker and dealer to fail to keep a record of the beneficial ownership of a cash account. The information stated that Bangerter did not have knowledge of the regulation that he caused to be violated.

During his guilty plea, Bangerter admitted that he was listed as the owner of the cash account and that he willfully caused the securities brokerage firm to fail to keep a record of the true owner of the account. [U.S. v. Gordon K. Bangerter, USDC for the District of Utah, Central Division, Criminal Action File No. 92-CR-0189-G] (LR-13423)

LESTER BOYNIICK ENTERS GUILTY PLEA AND IS SENTENCED

The Commission and the U.S. Attorney for the District of Utah announced that on October 14, 1992 Lester F. Boynick (Boynick) pleaded guilty to a one-count felony information and was sentenced by District Court Judge J. Thomas Greene to spend five years on probation and to perform 200 hours of community service. Boynick is from Gulfport, Louisiana.

The felony information was filed on July 21, 1992 and charged Boynick with having willfully utilized the means and instrumentalities of interstate commerce in facilitating and processing the sales of the stocks of Walsh Communications Group, Inc. (Walsh), while Boynick was in the possession of undisclosed material information about the ownership and control of the stock of Walsh.

During his guilty plea, Boynick admitted his knowledge of the control and planned market manipulation of the Walsh stock and of his activities in promoting and selling the stock. [U.S. v. Lester F. CRIMINAL INFORMATION FILED AGAINST BARRY FREEDMAN AND JOSEPH PIGNATIELLO

The Commission and U.S. Attorney Michael J. Norton of the District of Colorado announced the filing of an Information charging Barry H. Freedman of Parker, Colorado and Joseph V. Pignatiello of Englewood, Colorado with insider trading in the securities of Star Publications, Inc. The Information alleges that Freedman and Pignatiello purchased securities of Star Publications while in possession of material nonpublic information relating to a contemplated merger with Inner Vision, Inc., in breach of their respective fiduciary or other duties of trust and confidence.

Freedman and Pignatiello are defendants in SEC v. Power Securities Corporation, et al., Civil Action No. 90-S-1579, presently pending in the District of Colorado. The Commission's First Amended Complaint in that action charges Freedman and Pignatiello with the illegal conduct alleged in the Information, as well as other violations of the Federal securities laws. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the Cincinnati Stock Exchange (SR-CSE-92-05) to specify that approval of memberships by the CSE's Membership Committee is final, eliminating the requirement of further review by the CSE's Board of Trustees. (Rel. 34-31403)

ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.

Below is a list of recent filings of Schedules 13D and 14D, which includes the following information: Column 1 - the company purchased (top), and the name of the purchaser; Column 2 - the type of security purchased; Column 3 - the type of form filed; Column 4 - the date the transaction occurred; Column 5 - the current number of shares (in 000's) owned (top) and the current percent owned; Column 6 - the CUSIP number (top) and the percent owned; and Column 7 - the status of the filing, i.e., new, update or revision.
