ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

CHARLES E. PURDY III SANCTIONED

The Commission has accepted an offer of settlement from Charles E. Purdy III in connection with an administrative proceeding previously instituted on April 30, 1980. In his offer of settlement, Purdy consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the order for proceedings, to the issuance of the Commission's Findings and Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions. The Commission found that Purdy had wilfully violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 in connection with transactions in options on common stock in customer accounts. Based upon Purdy's offer of settlement, the Commission suspended Purdy from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company, or affiliate thereof for a period of four months. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE NARRAGANSETT ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing The Narragansett Electric Company, a subsidiary of New England Electric System, to issue and sell \$20 million principal amount of first mortgage bonds. The proceeds of the sale will be used to repay short-term debt. (Rel. 35-21666 - July 28)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The following have filed proposed rule changes under Rule 19b-4: The Midwest Stock Exchange, Inc. - (SR-MSE-80-13) to amend its rule governing off-floor transactions to conform with the requirements of Commission Rule 19c-3 under the Securities Exchange Act (Rel. 34-17013); and The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. - (SR-NYSE-80-25) to amend Exchange rules to provide for the operation of the Opening Automated Report Service and special trade comparison procedures implemented in conjunction with it to facilitate more efficient and accurate reporting of market orders received prior to the opening in individual stocks (Rel. 34-17014).

Publication of the above proposals is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of July 28.

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. has filed an amendment to previously filed proposed rule changes under Rule 19b-4 (SR-CBOE-80-16). This amendment clarifies certain market maker participation requirements and requires the recording of additional information on market makers' orders.

Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of July 28. (Rel. 34-17012)

STAY OF EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has stayed the effectiveness of the approval of the proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-Amex-80-13) to amend the Exchange's Constitution and rules to delete the primary purpose requirement for membership until the exchange files an amendment giving notice of approval of the proposed change by its membership.
