COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

AMERICAN DEPOSITARY RECEIPTS

The Commission is publishing for comment today a release soliciting information and comments with respect to American depository receipts (ADRs). The solicitation of information and comments is part of a review by the Commission of the marketplace for and regulations relating to ADRs. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GLOBAL INCOME PLUS FUND

Global Income Plus Fund, Inc. et al. have received a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Act and Rule 12d3-1 thereunder. The conditional order grants this exemption to the extent necessary to permit applicants to invest in equity or convertible debt securities of foreign issuers that derived more than 15% of their gross revenues from their activities as a broker, dealer, underwriter, or investment adviser, provided such investments meet the conditions described in proposed amended Rule 12d3-1. KEMPER SECURITIES GROUP

A conditional order has been issued pursuant to Section 9(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Kemper Securities Group, Inc. (Kemper) from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Act to relieve Kemper from any ineligibility resulting from the employment of two individuals who are subject to injunctions in Commission enforcement actions. UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES GRANTED

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by the Cincinnati Stock Exchange (SR-CSE-91-02) to amend CSE Rules 11.9(c)(v) and 11.9(n)(1) relating to public agency order guarantees at the opening. (Rel. 34-29227)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act to amend Appendix F to Article III, Section 34, of the NASD's Rules of Fair Practice. The amendment would, among other things, prohibit members from receiving differential compensation in connection with the solicitation of roll-up transactions. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 27. (Rel. 34-29228)

MISCELLANEOUS

SUMMARY EFFECTIVENESS OF AMENDMENT

The Options Price Reporting Authority (OPRA) has filed with the Commission under Rule 11Aa3-2 of the Securities Exchange Act an amendment to its national market system plan to establish a new fee for vendors who wish to offer a radio paging market data service and a rider to OPRA's vendor agreement to be used in connection with the new fee. The Commission, upon publication of the notice of the amendment in the Federal Register, will summarily put the amendment into effect on a temporary basis. Publication of the release is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 27. (Rel. 34-29214)

AMENDMENT TO NATIONAL MARKET SYSTEM PLAN

The Options Price Reporting Authority (OPRA) has filed an amendment pursuant to Rule 11Aa-3-2 of the Securities Exchange Act to its National Market System Plan to reflect changes to OPRA's existing New Service Direct Connection Agreement. Publication of the release is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 27. (Rel. 34-29215)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF AMENDMENT

The Options Price Reporting Authority (OPRA) has filed an amendment pursuant to Rule 11Aa3-2 to the Dial-Up Market Data Service Rider to OPRA's Vendor Agreement. The amendment became effective upon filing. Publication of the release is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 27. (Rel. 34-29216).

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
