CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTIONS AND DISGORGEMENT SOUGHT AGAINST GARY MCWHORTER AND STEVEN PERELMAN

The Chicago Regional Office announced that, on June 3, it filed a Complaint for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief in the U.S. District Court for the District of Minnesota seeking injunctions and disgorgement against Gary T. McWhorter and Steven L. Perelman for violations of Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a)(1)-(3) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5.

The complaint alleges that from approximately March 1986 to November 1986 McWhorter and Perelman offered and sold to some 60 investors unregistered securities in the form of common stock offerings in two venture companies raising approximately \$810,000. The offerings were structured as "blind venture capital pool" offerings whose undisclosed purpose was to fund entities in which McWhorter and Perelman had a direct or indirect financial interest.

The complaint further alleges that information supplied to investors through salesmen hired by McWhorter and Perelman contained false and misleading information about, among other things, the use of proceeds and the potential return on investment. DEFENDANTS PERMANENTLY ENJOINED IN LOUISIANA

The Fort Worth Regional and Houston Branch Offices announced that, on May 23, the Honorable Tom Stagg, U.S. Chief District Judge for the Western District of Louisiana, entered an Order of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief against defendants T.A. Robinson, Mike LeBlanc and James D. Callicott, all of Monroe, Louisiana, in a civil action alleging a securities fraud by an insurance holding company and others. The Court's Order permanently enjoins these defendants from engaging in further violations of the securities registration, broker-dealer and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

The Court also ordered the defendants to pay a disgorgement amount equal to the proceeds paid to them as a result of the activities alleged in the Commission's Complaint, plus prejudgment interest. The Court will determine the disgorgement amount and whether the defendants are able to make payment of such amount if the parties do not reach an agreement on these points. The defendants consented to the Order without admitting or denying the allegations. A number of Louisiana state criminal actions are pending as to these defendants. [SEC v. ALIC Corporation, Glen D. THOMAS WACKER ENJOINED

The Denver Regional Office announced that, on May 30, a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction was entered by the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado against Thomas J. Wacker (Wacker). Wacker consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, to a permanent injunction from future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Wacker further consented to an order of disgorgement of profits, which was waived based on proof of inability to pay. The complaint alleged that Wacker and other defendants offered and sold contracts for investments in gold and that Wacker, among others, acted fraudulently. See LR-12636, LR-12759 and LR-12817. [SEC v. Wacker Marketing, Inc. et al., Civil Action No. 90-F-1712] (LR-12883)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
