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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED, FINDINGS MADE AND A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER IMPOSED AGAINST DAVID SHIHADA

The Commission has instituted administrative proceedings, made findings and imposed a cease and desist order against David Shihada (Shihada) of Miami, Florida. Shihada was formerly the president of Chase America Corporation, whose common stock was traded

in the National Quotation Service's "pink sheets" from May to November 1988. The Commission has accepted an Offer of Settlement, in which Shihada consents, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, to the entry of an Order Making Findings and Imposing a Cease and Desist Order (Order). The Order contains findings by the Commission that Shihada violated Section 10(b) and Rule 10b-5 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Order requires Shihada to cease and desist from committing or causing a violation or future violation of these provisions. (Rel. 34-32493)

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## **CIVIL PROCEEDINGS**

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### **CIVIL ACTION AGAINST GCP FINANCIAL, INC., GRANT ROSS AND MICHAEL DOHERTY, JR.**

The Commission announced that on June 22 the Honorable J.P. Vukasin, Jr. of the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California entered a preliminary injunction and other orders (Order) against defendants GCP Financial, Inc., Grant C. Ross and Michael J. Doherty. The Order, which was consented to by the defendants, continues the relief previously granted by the Court in its Temporary Restraining Order issued on June 16, 1993.

The Commission's complaint, filed on June 15 alleges that GCP has engaged in the business of offering and selling unregistered securities to the general public, obtaining approximately \$6.9 million from approximately 150 investors via the securities offering. The complaint also alleges GCP, Ross, Doherty and their agents have made numerous misrepresentations and omissions concerning the securities that they have offered and sold, have failed to transmit investors' funds for the projects for which they were purportedly raised, and have converted such funds to their own use.

The Order preliminarily enjoins the defendants from violating, directly or indirectly, Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The defendants are further preliminarily enjoined from directly or indirectly, effecting transactions in, and inducing or attempting to induce the purchase or sale of securities without being registered as a broker-dealer pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Exchange Act. The Order further preliminarily enjoins the defendants from transferring assets or destroying records and continues the freeze of GCP's assets, the appointment of a temporary receiver for GCP, and the expedited discovery schedule requested by the Commission. 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## **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

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### **THE GUARDIAN INSURANCE & ANNUITY COMPANY, INC., ET AL.**

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 19, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Guardian Insurance & Annuity Company, Inc., The Guardian Separate Account J (Separate Account) and Guardian Investors Services

Corporation (collectively, Applicants), for an order of the Commission pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting the Applicants from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(35), 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a premium-based sales load and mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Separate Account under certain single premium deferred variable annuity contracts. 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### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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#### NORTHEAST UTILITIES, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Northeast Utilities (Northeast), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary companies, Holyoke Water Power Company, Western Massachusetts Electric Company (WMECO), Quinnehtuk Company, Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH), North Atlantic Energy Corporation (North Atlantic), The Connecticut Light & Power Company, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company, The Rocky River Realty Company (Rocky River) and HEC Inc. (HEC) (collectively, Applicants). The Applicants propose to add HEC to the Northeast Utilities System Money Pool (Money Pool) for borrowings up to \$11 million pursuant to the same terms and conditions established by HCAR No. 25710 (December 16, 1992) (December 1992 Order), but only insofar as funds borrowed by HEC are contributed to the Money Pool by Northeast. The Applicants also propose to increase Rocky River's short-term borrowing authorization from \$15 million (which was granted pursuant to the December Order) to \$25 million. Jurisdiction is reserved over PSNH's, North Atlantic's and HEC's borrowings of Money Pool funds attributable to WMECO's contributions thereto. (Rel. 35-25836)

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-93-19) to extend market-maker margin and capital treatment to certain market-maker orders entered off the CBOE trading floor. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 28. (Rel. 34-32500)

The Pacific Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-92-42) to adopt listing requirements for common stock that qualifies under the Small Corporate Offering Registration (SCOR) classification. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 28. (Rel. 34-32514)

### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange to reduce its Automated System Access Privilege (ASAP) Membership fees (SR-PSE-93-05) has become effective upon filing. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 28. (Rel. 34-32509)

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-92-15) filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange which adds detailed procedures to the PSE's Minor Rule Plan and modifies the PSE's summary sanction procedure. The proposal also amends the following PSE rules on an accelerated basis: Rule 10.4 and other rules governing hearings and appeals; Rule 6.2, governing admission to and conduct on the options trading floor; and Rule 2.12, which establishes fines for the late filing of Financial and Operational Combined Uniform Single reports. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 28. (Rel. 34-32510)
