### CHAIRMAN LEVITT TO TESTIFY

Chairman Levitt will testify before the Senate Subcommittee on Securities on Wednesday, November 10, at 10:00 a.m., in Room 538 of the Dirksen Senate Office Building. The testimony is concerning the investment company industry.

### FERNANDO ALEGRIA APPOINTED ASSOCIATE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE AND PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT

On October 20, 1993, Chairman Arthur Levitt appointed Fernando Alegria as Associate Executive Director of the Office of Administrative and Personnel Management (OAPM). The Office oversees personnel activities and facilities management. These activities include recruitment and staffing, employee compensation and benefits, training, employee/management relations, contracting, space management, printing, mail services and property management. ## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### ORDER ENTERED AGAINST ARTHUR DEMARTINE

The Commission announced that on October 25, 1993 the Honorable Harvey E. Schlesinger, U.S. District Judge for the Middle District of Florida, entered an Order, by consent, requiring Arthur L. DeMartine (DeMartine) of Homosassa, Florida to disgorge \$455,595, plus prejudgment interest, but waiving payment based on DeMartine's financial inability to pay.

The Commission alleged in its complaint, filed on June 27, 1991, that DeMartine, while employed as a branch manager for Raymond James & Associates, Inc., misappropriated investor funds that were intended for the purchase of securities. On July 5, 1991, the Court entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction, by consent (See LR-12912 and LR-12964). [SEC v. Arthur L. DeMartine, MD FL, Jacksonville Division, Civil Action No. 91-495-CIV-J-14] (LR-13861)

### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-93-44) for the purpose of issuing a Regulatory Circular relating to certain floor brokerage practices. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 8. (Rel. 34-33155)

The National Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-93-11) to permit NSCC to revise its membership capital standards and its clearing fund requirements for entities that will use only NSCC's mutual fund services. (Rel. 34-33157)

### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Midwest Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-MCC-93-06) relating to waiving certain fees. The rule change was effective upon filing. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 8. (Rel. 34-33156)
