COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CHAIRMAN LEVITT ANNOUNCES RESULTS OF SEC'S MUTUAL FUND SURVEY

Chairman Levitt today released the results of a survey commissioned by the SEC's Office of Economic Analysis in order to discern the degree to which investors understand the risks associated with mutual funds. A key result of the survey indicates that 66 percent of bank fund holders believe that money market mutual funds sold through banks are federally insured. (Press Rel. 93-55)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

SALVATORE LANZA BARRED

The Commission has instituted public administrative proceedings against Salvatore A. Lanza (Lanza), formerly a principal of Bachus & Stratton Securities, Inc., a now defunct broker-dealer, and simultaneously accepted Lanza's Offer of Settlement in which he consented to the issuance of an order barring him from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. The bar is based on an injunction entered against Lanza in United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas (SEC v. Glenn A. Schuster, et al., H-92-3598) that permanently enjoins him from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The Commission's complaint alleged that Lanza participated in a fraudulent distribution of the securities of Bancus Richmond, Inc. (Bancus), by establishing a securities account that, although maintained in his name, allowed the distribution of Bancus securities by undisclosed control persons. Lanza consented to the entry of the injunction without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's complaint. (Rel. 34-33136)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST JAMES ALLBRANDT

The Central Regional Office announced that on November 3 the Commission filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado seeking a permanent

Injunction against, and an accounting, civil penalties and disgorgement from James L. Allbrandt, formerly of Englewood, Colorado, based on violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

According to the complaint, Allbrandt, a lawyer, made untrue statements of, and omitted to disclose, material facts in connection with the offer and sale securities relating to his Freedom and Discovery Aftermarket Trading Programs which he operated out of his Englewood, Colorado law office in 1990 and 1991. The complaint further alleges that Allbrandt diverted approximately \$445,000 of aftermarket trading program investor money for his personal use. [SEC v. James L. Allbrandt, USDC, D. NATIONAL LIQUIDATORS, INC. AND VANCE WOLFE RESTRAINED

The Commission announced that on October 29, 1993 the Honorable J.D. Holschuh, Chief Judge, U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Ohio, issued a temporary restraining order against National Liquidators, Inc., (NLI) a debtor in bankruptcy, and Vance K. Wolfe (Wolfe) of Galena, Ohio, restraining them from further violations of Section 5(a), 5(c), 17(a)(1), 17(a)(2) and 17(a)(3) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The Court also restrained both Wolfe and NLI from destroying documents and Wolfe from selling, assigning or pledging any major asset without prior order of the Court.

In its complaint, the Commission alleged that from January 1991 through September 1993 Wolfe, the president and sole shareholder of NLI until his resignation on October 18, 1993, and NLI raised approximately \$43 million from the offer and sale of unregistered securities to approximately one thousand investors. Wolfe and NLI purportedly used investor funds to purchase merchandise to be resold to liquidation outlets and discount retail stores, however, most of the money solicited after early 1992, approximately \$35 million, was misappropriated or diverted by Wolfe and NLI for improper purposes. [SEC v. Vance K. Wolfe, et al., Civil Action No. C2-93-1014, USDC, SD Ohio] (LR-13863)

PERMANENT INJUNCTION OBTAINED AGAINST LOUIS FOTI

The Commission announced that on October 18, 1993 a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction was entered in the U.S. District Court for the District of Utah enjoining Louis S. Foti from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder.

The complaint alleged that Foti engaged in a scheme to sell a large block of unrestricted common stock of New Minority Ventures, Inc. to an undercover agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation who was posing as a purchaser interested in manipulating the price of the company's stock. Foti also failed to disclose in a prospectus made available to the public that he controlled virtually all of the free-trading and restricted stock in New Minority.

Foti consented to the entry of the injunction without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's complaint. [SEC v. Louis S. Foti, USDC, D. Utah, Civil Action No. C93-822A] (LR-13865)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

WHITE RIVER CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 3, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by White River Corporation for an order under Sections 6(c) and 6(e) of the Investment Company Act. Applicant was created as part of a reorganization of Fund American Enterprises Holdings, Inc. (FAEH) as a wholly-owned subsidiary of FAEH. As part of the reorganization, FAEH plans to distribute to its shareholders a majority of its holdings in applicant. Because of applicant's asset composition, applicant falls within the definition of an investment company under the Act, however, it plans to engage in a non-investment company business. Accordingly, applicant seeks a temporary exemption from all provisions of the Act except Sections 9, 17(a) (as modified in the application), 17(d) (as modified), 17(e) (as modified), 17(f), and 36 through 53, and the rules thereunder. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
