NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GPU NUCLEAR CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 16 to request a hearing on a proposal by GPU Nuclear Corporation (GPU-Nuclear), a wholly owned service company subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), and by GPU. GPU-Nuclear proposes to form a new subsidiary (NewCo) for the purpose of carrying out radiological decontamination and asbestos removal services under a proposed contract with Westinghouse Electric Corporation (Westinghouse), such services to be performed at the Bettis Atomic Power Laboratory, West Mifflin, Pennsylvania, which is operated by Westinghouse for the U.S. Department of Energy. NewCo also proposes to issue and sell to GPU-Nuclear, for a total of \$100, 100 shares of its common stock. In addition, NewCo proposes to borrow through December 31, 1992, either from banks or from GPU, up to \$1 million outstanding at any time to fund the cost of providing services under the Westinghouse contract. GPU-Nuclear will also provide certain administrative services to NewCo, at cost. (Rel. 35- 25007)

NEW ENGLAND ENERGY INCORPORATED

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing New England Energy Incorporated (NEEI), the fuel supply subsidiary of New England Electric System, to contribute up to \$50 million, through December 31, 1991, to its partnership (Partnership) with Samedan Oil Corporation (Samedan), a subsidiary of Noble Affiliates, Inc., a nonaffiliate, to meet NEEI's share of expenses for further exploration and development of oil and gas properties acquired by the Partnership through December 31, 1986. Jurisdiction has been reserved over NEEI's contribution of an additional \$10 million to Samedan, through December 31, 1991, pending completion of the record. (Rel. 35-25008)

CSW CREDIT, INC., ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Central and South West Corporation (CSW) and CSW Credit, Inc. (Credit), CSW's nonutility subsidiary, for Credit to change its debt-to-equity ratio from 80% debt and 20% equity to a requirement that the equity component be no less than 15%. In addition, CSW and Credit are seeking an extension of the previous authorization to factor the accounts receivable of CSW's subsidiaries and nonassociated utilities to December 31, 1990. (Rel. 35-25009)

EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES EUA COGENEX CORPORATION

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Eastern Utilities Associates (EUA) and EUA Cogenex Corporation, its wholly owned nonutility subsidiary, for EUA through December 31, 1991 to purchase the common stock of, and make capital contributions and/or short-term loans to, EUA Cogenex in an aggregate amount of up to \$30 million. EUA proposes to finance its obligations by short-term borrowings under existing bank lines of credit and from the proceeds of the public offering of additional EUA common shares, which is the subject of SEC File No. 70-7511.

Additionally, EUA Cogenex proposes to borrow from the EUA System's credit lines up to an aggregate of \$25 million of short-term borrowings, which EUA proposes to guarantee. (Rel. 35-25010)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-PHLX-89-57) has filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 that, among other things, would extend the ten-up guarantee to displayed or screen markets for quotations in the two near-term months for all options, rather than just the best quoted market in the trading crowd. Publication of the proposal is expected to appear in the Federal Register during the week of January 8. (Rel. 34-27573)
