### DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY TO DIRECTOR OF MARKET REGULATION

The Commission amended its Rules of Practice to delegate authority to the Director of the Division of Market Regulation to publish notice of and, by order, grant under Section 11A(b) of the Securities Exchange Act, and Rule 11Ab2-1: applications for registration as a securities information processor; and exemptions from that Section and any rules or regulations promulgated thereunder, either conditionally or unconditionally. Publication of the release in the Federal Register is expected during the week of May 7, 1990. (Rel. 34-27960)

## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

---

### FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT SERVICES OF NORTHERN VIRGINIA, THOMAS EDWARD LAPPLE SANCTIONED

The Commission has instituted public administrative proceedings pursuant to Sections 203(e) and 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act against Financial Management Services of Northern Virginia, Inc. and Thomas Edward Lapple. Simultaneously with the institution of the proceedings, they submitted an Offer of Settlement which the

Commission accepted. The respondents consented to the Order, without admitting or denying the findings contained therein except as to the entry of a civil injunctive action, which they admitted.

On the basis of the Order Instituting Proceedings and the Offer of Settlement, the Commission found that Financial Management and Lapple, on April 18, 1990, were permanently enjoined from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act, Securities Exchange Act, and Investment Advisers Act, and ordered to disgorge \$517,200. The Commissions' Complaint alleged that in connection with the offer and sale of securities, Financial Management and Lapple made misrepresentations and omissions of material facts to investors.

Based on the above findings and the Offer of Settlement, Lapple was barred from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company or investment adviser. Furthermore, the registration of Financial Management as an investment adviser was revoked. (Rel. IA-1226)

## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

---

### APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION AND TEMPORARY EXEMPTION

The National Association of Securities Dealers (NASD) has filed an application for registration of its subsidiary, Market Services, Inc., as an "exclusive securities information processor" for the operation of the PORTAL Market, under Section 11A(b)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 11Ab2-1. The Commission granted a temporary exemption from registration for a period of 90 days to allow the NASD to operate the PORTAL Market until the Commission has completed its review of the securities information processor application. Publication of the Release in the Federal Register is expected during the week of May 7.

Comments must be received no later than 21 days following publication in the Federal Register and should refer to File No. S7-9-90. (Rel. 34-27957)

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-88-19) that establishes a one-year pilot program testing a new service, the OTC Bulletin Board Display Service, for securities traded over-the-counter that are neither included in the NASDAQ System nor listed on a national securities exchange. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
