GPU SERVICE CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by GPU Service Corporation, Jersey Central Power & Light Company, Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company, and GPU Nuclear Corporation (collectively, GPU Companies), wholly-owned subsidiaries of General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company, to grant, from time to time, through December 31, 1995, to nonassociate companies, nonexclusive licenses to computer programs developed by the GPU Companies for use in their public-utility business, and to provide certain support services in connection with the licensing of such programs. CSW CREDIT, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, and its nonutility subsidiary, CSW Credit, Inc. (Credit), to change Credit's equity ratio to a requirement that it be no less than 5%. (Rel. 35-25138 - August 30)

THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by the Columbia Gas System, Inc. (Columbia), a registered holding company, and certain of its subsidiaries, including Columbia Gulf Transmission Company (Columbia Transmission), whereby Columbia Transmission would increase the amount of first mortgage bonds it is authorized to issue to Columbia through December 31, 1991 to \$625 million, and Columbia would amend its \$500 Million Credit Agreement (Credit Agreement) with the termination date of October 5, 1993, to add a Money Market Option to the alternate pricing provisions. MISSISSIPPI POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

MP&L has also been authorized to acquire notes from its customers in connection with its financing of its customers' purchases of equipment and services under the Programs. IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE

A proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-90-30) to specify the duration of the fee and charge waiver with respect to two Salomon Brothers, Inc., index warrants on the FT-SE 100 has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act. (Rel. 34-28384)

APPROVAL OF RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change submitted by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-89-53) to amend the NASD's By-Laws to require a person whose registration with the NASD has been revoked for failure to pay any fine, monetary sanction or costs assessed as a result of disciplinary action by the NASD to requalify by examination prior to again becoming registered. (Rel. 34-28389)

AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

An amendment to a proposed rule change has been filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-90-18) to change certain aspects of the proposal regarding the required number of market makers, the price of the securities listed on the NASDAQ system, and the effective date of the proposed rule change which introduces new criteria for initial and continued inclusion of securities in the NASDAQ system. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of September 3. (Rel. 34-28391)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-90-45) filed a proposed rule change under Section 19(b)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act to amend the Uniform Application for Securities Industry Registration or Transfer, Form U-4, in order to allow a previously registered person to certify to the completeness and accuracy of his disciplinary record in the Central Registration Depository System and alleviate the need for resubmit full details of all reportable items upon the transfer of his registration to a new broker-dealer. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of September 3. (Rel. 34-28392)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-90-46) which would amend the NASD's Schedule C of the By-Laws to allow persons registered with The Securities Association of the United Kingdom to qualify as general securities representatives (Series 7) by passing a modified general securities examination developed by the New
