COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

TRILATERAL COMMUNIQUE ISSUED

A Trilateral Communique on Cooperation Between the Securities and Exchange Commission of the United States of America, the Department of Trade and Industry and the Securities and Investments Board of the United Kingdom and the Securities Bureau of the Ministry of Finance of Japan is being released today.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTIVE ACTION AGAINST DAVID S. QUINTANA

On September 19, the Commission filed an injunctive action in the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California against David S. Quintana of Los Angeles, California. The complaint alleged that Quintana, in his operation of Rochester Financial, Inc., a registered investment adviser, made false representations and omitted to state material facts while offering interests in a purported options trading fund and a real estate partnership. The complaint further alleged that Quintana prepared and distributed advertisements which contained false information regarding his and his wife's qualifications and provided clients with disclosure and other documents which contained materially false statements. It was also alleged that Quintana commingled client funds, failed to keep required books and records, filed a materially false amendment to Form ADV and was responsible for the firm's violative advisory contracts.

Quintana, while neither admitting nor denying the Commission's allegations, consented to be permanently enjoined from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and Sections 204, 205, 206(1), 206(2), 206(4) and 207 of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 and Rules 204-2, 206(4)-1 and 206(4)-2 thereunder. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned service company subsidiary, GPU Service Corporation (Services), whereby Services would enter into a new term loan agreement (Agreement) with the Bank of New York (Bank) and issue to the Bank an unsecured note (Note) in the principal amount of \$12.4 million, with a maturity date of September 30, 1993. GPU has been authorized to unconditionally guarantee payment of the principal and interest on the Note and Service's other obligations to the Bank under the Agreement. (Rel. 35-25154)

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Georgia Power Company, a wholly owned electric public-utility subsidiary company of The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to sell, on or before June 30, 1991, to J.C. Penney Company, Inc. certain distribution facilities serving the J.C. Penney Catalog Distribution Center, located in Forest Park, Georgia, for \$1.155 million. (Rel. 35-25153)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed by the following pursuant to Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act: Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-90-05) to provide an earlier guarantee for options transactions and to eliminate OCC's ability to reject reported options transactions for non-payment of the premium (Rel. 34-28446); and National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-90-01) to mandate that certain NASD members participate in reconfirmation and repricing services offered by registered clearing agencies (Rel. 34-28447). Publication of the proposals is expected in the Federal Register during the week of September 17.

Two proposed rule changes have been filed by the New York Stock Exchange pursuant to Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act: SR-NYSE-90-40 to amend NYSE Rules 116.40, 123A.43 and 13 in order to modify NYSE procedures for handling and executing market-on-close (MOC) orders on expiration Fridays by allowing for partial executions of MOC orders, with Floor Governor approval, when significant imbalances occur (Rel. 34-28452); and SR-NYSE-90-39 to amend NYSE Rule 72 to provide that agency block transactions, where both orders are for an account other than that of a member or member organization, can be effected without interference at the proposed cross price. The proposal also provides that the cross may be broken up at a price that is better than the proposed price for one side or the other (Rel. 34-28453). Publication of the proposals is expected in the Federal Register during the week of September 24.

AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION

On September 13, the MBS Clearing Corporation filed an amendment to its application for registration as a clearing agency. MBSCC's amendment requests that the Commission extend MBSCC's registration as a clearing agency for a period of one year and approve MBSCC's application for registration as a clearing agency on a permanent basis. Publication of notice of MBSCC's request is expected to appear in the Federal Register during the week of September 17. (Rel. 34-28451)
