STAFF LEGAL BULLETIN NO. 5 RELATING TO YEAR 2000 DISCLOSURE ISSUES REVISED

The Divisions of Corporation Finance and Investment Management have published a revised Staff Legal Bulletin No. 5. Revised Staff Legal Bulletin No. 5 (CF/IM) states the Divisions' views regarding companies' disclosure obligations regarding Year 2000 issues. RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

COMMISSION ADOPTS RULE CHANGES TO THE BENEFICIAL OWNERSHIP REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

The Commission has issued a release adopting amendments to the rules relating to the reporting of beneficial ownership in publicly-held companies. The amendments make Schedule 13G available, in lieu of Schedule 13D, to all investors beneficially owning less than 20 percent of the outstanding class of securities that have not acquired or held the securities for the purpose of and do not have the effect of changing or influencing the control of the issuer of the securities. The purposes of the amendments are to improve the effectiveness of the beneficial ownership reporting scheme and to reduce the reporting obligations of passive investors. BRET BOTELER RECEIVES BAR IN SETTLED ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

The Commission today announced the institution of public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 on January 9 against Bret L. Boteler, formerly a registered representative of Kinlaw Securities Corporation, a now defunct broker-dealer firm. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Boteler's Offer of Settlement. The Commission found that on December 18, 1997, Boteler was permanently enjoined by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas (SEC v. Kinlaw Securities Corporation, et al., 3:93CV2010-T). Boteler consented to the entry of the permanent injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's First Amended Complaint.

The First Amended Complaint alleged that the defendants, including Boteler, engaged in the offer, purchase and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts involving interests in oil and gas drilling ventures in violation of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The First Amended Complaint further alleged that in connection with the offer, purchase and sale of these securities, the defendants made material misrepresentations and omissions of material fact concerning, among other things, the risks and expected returns associated with the oil and gas investments, the costs to drill and complete oil and gas wells, and the success of prior oil and gas wells.

The Order provides that Boteler be barred from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. (Rel. 34-39533; File No. 3-9525)

DYKE FERRELL RECEIVES BAR IN SETTLED ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

The Commission today announced the institution of public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 on January 9 against Dyke Ferrell (Ferrell), formerly a registered representative of Kinlaw Securities Corporation, a now defunct broker-dealer firm. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Ferrell's Offer of Settlement. The Commission found that on December 18, 1997, Ferrell was permanently enjoined by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas (SEC v. Kinlaw Securities Corporation, et al., 3:93CV2010-T). Ferrell consented to the entry of the permanent injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's First Amended Complaint.

The First Amended Complaint alleged that the defendants, including Ferrell, engaged in the offer, purchase and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts involving interests in oil and gas

drilling ventures in violation of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The First Amended Complaint further alleged that in connection with the offer, purchase and sale of these securities, the defendants made material misrepresentations and omissions of material fact concerning, among other things, the risks and expected returns associated with the oil and gas investments, the costs to drill and complete oil and gas wells, and the success of prior oil and gas wells.

The Order provides that Ferrell be barred from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. (Rel. 34-39534; File No. 3-9526)

JAMES BOSWELL RECEIVES BAR IN SETTLED ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

The Commission today announced the institution of public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 on January 9 against James B. Boswell, formerly a registered representative of Kinlaw Securities Corporation, a now defunct broker-dealer firm. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Boswell's Offer of Settlement. The Commission found that on December 23, 1997, Boswell was permanently enjoined by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas (SEC v. Kinlaw Securities Corporation, et al., 3:93CV2010-T). Boswell consented to the entry of the permanent injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's First Amended Complaint.

The First Amended Complaint alleged that the defendants, including Boswell, engaged in the offer, purchase and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts involving interests in oil and gas drilling ventures in violation of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The First Amended Complaint further alleged that in connection with the offer, purchase and sale of these securities, the defendants made material misrepresentations and omissions of material fact concerning, among other things, the risks and expected returns associated with the oil and gas investments, the costs to drill and complete oil and gas wells, and the success of prior oil and gas wells.

CECIL GLASS III RECEIVES BAR IN SETTLED ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

The Commission today announced the institution of public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 on January 9 against Cecil R. Glass III, formerly a registered representative of Kinlaw Securities Corporation, a now defunct broker-dealer firm. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Glass' Offer of Settlement. The Commission found that on December 23, 1997, Glass was permanently enjoined by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas (SEC v. Kinlaw Securities Corporation, et al., 3:93CV2010-T). Glass consented to the entry of

the permanent injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's First Amended Complaint.

The First Amended Complaint alleged that the defendants, including Glass, engaged in the offer, purchase and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts involving interests in oil and gas drilling ventures in violation of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The First Amended Complaint further alleged that in connection with the offer, purchase and sale of these securities, the defendants made material misrepresentations and omissions of material fact concerning, among other things, the risks and expected returns associated with the oil and gas investments, the costs to drill and complete oil and gas wells, and the success of prior oil and gas wells.

The Order provides that Glass be barred from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. (Rel. 34-39536; File No. 3-9528)

FROZEN FUNDS ORDERED TO BE DISBURSED TO VICTIMS OF RECIDIVIST SECURITIES VIOLATOR

The Commission announced that on January 5 the Honorable Richard A. Paez, United States District Judge, entered an order that monies frozen in this action be disbursed to investors, and appointing a disbursing agent. Additionally, on December 23, 1997, Judge Paez entered default judgments against the defendants in this action, Affordable Prepaid Cellular, Inc., and its owner, John C. Rockett (Rockett). The default judgments also ordered disgorgement in the amount of \$1,338,709.79 together with prejudgment interest of \$37,524.95, jointly and severally, against APC and Rockett.

Approximately \$280,600 of the \$1,355,000 raised from investors was frozen pursuant to an order freezing the assets of APC and Rockett, and will be disbursed to investors, resulting in a return of approximately 20 cents per dollar invested. The frozen funds were awarded to the Commission as disgorgement, and will be disbursed to investors on a pro-rata basis.

The Commission alleged that APC and Rockett, a recidivist securities violator, fraudulently offered and sold securities in the form of \$5,000 corporate notes, to at least 100 individuals since December 1996. APC promised that investors' monies would be used to fund APC's business operations, providing prepaid cellular telephone service to "credit-challenged" individuals. Instead, Rockett misused and misappropriated at least \$600,000 of the \$1,355,000 raised from investors. Rockett also failed to inform investors that he had a long history of securities law violations, including being twice convicted for selling fraudulent investments and being the subject of numerous state orders for violating state securities laws.
