MEDIA ADVISORY

SEC Chairman Arthur Levitt will lead an Investors' Town Meeting in Palo Alto, California, on Tuesday, February 17. Levitt will be joined by U.S. Representative Anna Eshoo and Brian Thompson, Chief Deputy Commissioner of California's Department of Corporations.

Through the dramatic growth of employer sponsored 401(k)s and other defined contribution retirement plans, more Americans than ever are invested in stocks and bonds. Too many, however, lack the basic facts they need about saving and investing to achieve financial security and avoid costly mistakes.

"We want people to know the questions they should ask about investments and the people who sell them. That way they can better protect themselves," Levitt said. The SEC Chairman will also offer basic tips on how to invest wisely and avoid problems.

The Town Meeting, followed by investment seminars, will be held at the Hyatt Richeys, 4219 El Camino Real, Palo Alto. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

TRO OBTAINED AGAINST PAUL CATCHINGS

On February 10, the Commission filed an amended complaint and obtained emergency relief in a pending action in U.S. District Court for the District of Wyoming. Judge William F. Downes issued a TRO and other relief against Paul D. Catchings, who is the president and chief executive officer of Compunomics 139, Inc., and who was added as a defendant in the amended complaint. This civil action was originally filed by the Commission on February 2, 1998 (SEC v. First Zurich National USA, LLC, et al., Civil Action No. 98-CV-29D, USDC Wy.).

The amended complaint alleges that the defendants have been fraudulently offering and selling stock in Compunomics and First Zurich National USA, LLC since April 1995. The amended complaint alleges that the defendants are making false representations to investors about the potential value of Compunomics' stock, as well as failing to disclose that First Zurich cannot legally operate as a bank. The amended complaint further alleges that the defendants have sold between \$4 million and \$5 million of Compunomics and First Zurich stock. Between 1,000 and 2,000 investors have purchased Compunomics stock and at least 400 investors have purchased First Zurich stock. For further information, see LR-15634. [SEC v. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PIMCO VARIABLE INSURANCE TRUST, ET AL.

An order has been issued exempting PIMCO Variable Insurance Trust and Pacific Investment Management Company from Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a) and 15(b) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) thereunder. The order permits shares of PIMCO Variable Insurance Trust and any similar investment companies for which Pacific Investment Management Company or any of its affiliates may in the future serve as manager, investment adviser, administrator, principal underwriter or sponsor to be sold to and held by: (1) separate accounts funding variable annuity and variable life insurance contracts issued by both affiliated and unaffiliated life insurance companies; and (2) qualified pension and retirement plans outside of the separate account context. SARATOGA ADVANTAGE TRUST, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Saratoga

Advantage Trust and Saratoga Capital Management under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 15(a) of the Act, Rule 18f-2 under the Act, and certain disclosure requirements under the Act. The order permits applicants to enter into and materially amend investment advisory agreements without obtaining shareholder approval, and grants relief from certain disclosure requirements regarding advisory fees paid to subadvisers. IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Stock Clearing Corporation of Philadelphia filed a proposed rule change (SR-SCCP-97-05), which became effective upon filing, amending SCCP's fee schedule for a trade recording. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 16. (Rel. 34-39630)

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-98-09), which became effective upon filing, relating to the removal of quotations from the OTC Bulletin Board of certain American Depositary Receipts representing underlying shares in Cifra, S.A. de D.V., a foreign private issuer organized under the laws of Mexico. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 16. (Rel. 34-39632)
